## **SENATE BILL No. 1469**

## September 10, 2008, Introduced by Senator SWITALSKI and referred to the Committee on Commerce and Tourism.

A bill to amend 2000 PA 92, entitled "Food law of 2000," by amending section 4115 (MCL 289.4115) and by adding section 4115a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 4115. (1) A water bottler or water dispensing machine
 owner shall register with the department each brand of bottled
 water with a unique declaration of identity before the sale or
 offering for sale of the water. The application for registration
 shall be made on a form prescribed by the department and shall
 include both of the following:

7 (a) The proposed label or placard for the water. THE LABEL
8 SHALL INDICATE THE CAFFEINE CONTENT, IF ANY.

(b) For each year or portion of a year, a registration fee of
 \$25.00 for each brand of water with a unique declaration of
 identity and \$25.00 for each water dispensing machine.

4 (2) The registration required by subsection (1) expires
5 annually on April 30 and shall be renewed 30 calendar days before
6 expiration of the current registration.

7 (3) The department shall assess a late fee of \$25.00 for
8 bottled water or water from a water dispensing machine that is sold
9 or offered for sale without registration. A registration is not
10 effective until the late fee is paid.

SEC. 4115A. ANY BOTTLED DRINK NOT SUBJECT TO SECTION 4115
 SHALL HAVE INDICATED, UPON ITS LABEL, THE CAFFEINE CONTENT. THE
 LABELING SHALL BE AS PROVIDED BY LAW OR ORDER OF THE DIRECTOR.
