## HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 722

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 21529; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 21529. (1) BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2010, A HOSPITAL SHALL
- 2 ESTABLISH A SEASONAL INFLUENZA IMMUNIZATION POLICY. THE SEASONAL
- 3 INFLUENZA IMMUNIZATION POLICY SHALL BE CONSISTENT WITH GUIDELINES
- 4 OR RECOMMENDATIONS ISSUED BY THE FEDERAL CENTERS FOR DISEASE
- 5 CONTROL AND PREVENTION OR BY THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON IMMUNIZATION
- 6 PRACTICES OF THE FEDERAL CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND
- 7 PREVENTION. A HOSPITAL SHALL INCLUDE ALL OF THE FOLLOWING IN ITS

- 1 SEASONAL INFLUENZA IMMUNIZATION POLICY:
- 2 (A) A PROCEDURAL PLAN FOR MANAGING ITS SUPPLY OF ANY INFLUENZA
- 3 VACCINE.
- 4 (B) PROCEDURES FOR IDENTIFYING INDIVIDUALS 65 YEARS OF AGE OR
- 5 OLDER AND, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE HOSPITAL, OTHER PATIENTS AT
- 6 RISK, WHO ARE ADMITTED TO THE HOSPITAL.
- 7 (C) PROCEDURES FOR OFFERING IMMUNIZATION AGAINST THE INFLUENZA
- 8 VIRUS DURING THE INFLUENZA SEASON TO INDIVIDUALS 65 YEARS OF AGE OR
- 9 OLDER AND, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE HOSPITAL, OTHER PATIENTS AT
- 10 RISK, WHO ARE ADMITTED TO THE HOSPITAL FOR A PERIOD OF 24 HOURS OR
- 11 MORE.
- 12 (D) PROCEDURES FOR ENSURING THAT AN INDIVIDUAL OFFERED THE
- 13 INFLUENZA VACCINATION OR THE INDIVIDUAL'S AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE
- 14 RECEIVES INFORMATION REGARDING THE RISKS AND BENEFITS OF THE
- 15 INFLUENZA VACCINATION.
- 16 (E) A STANDING ORDER POLICY APPROVED BY THE MEDICAL DIRECTOR
- 17 OR OTHER APPROPRIATE HEALTH PROFESSIONAL THAT INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT
- 18 LIMITED TO, AN ASSESSMENT FOR MEDICAL CONTRAINDICATION TO
- 19 ADMINISTERING THE INFLUENZA VACCINATION.
- 20 (F) A SYSTEM FOR DOCUMENTING INFLUENZA VACCINATION
- 21 ADMINISTRATION, MEDICAL CONTRAINDICATIONS, PATIENT REFUSALS, AND
- 22 ANY POSTVACCINATION ADVERSE EVENTS.
- 23 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "INFLUENZA SEASON" MEANS THAT
- 24 PERIOD BETWEEN OCTOBER 1 AND MARCH 1.
- 25 (3) THIS SECTION IS REPEALED EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 2012.
- 26 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 27 unless House Bill No. 4172 of the 95th Legislature is enacted into
