

# SENATE BILL No. 766

August 26, 2009, Introduced by Senators JELINEK, PAPPAGEORGE and KUIPERS and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled  
"The code of criminal procedure,"  
by amending section 16v of chapter XVII (MCL 777.16v), as amended  
by 2008 PA 412.

### 1 CHAPTER XVII
