5	Sec. 201. In accordance with the provisions of section 30 of
6	article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending
7	from state resources in this appropriation act for the fiscal year
8	ending September 30, 2010 is \$0.00 and state appropriations paid to
9	local units of government are \$0.
LO	Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized
L1	under this act and the departments, commissions, boards, offices,
L2	and programs for which appropriations are made under this act are
L3	subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101
L4	to 18.1594.
L5	Sec. 203. The line-item appropriations in part 1 financed by
L6	federal funds designated as ARRA funding represent federal funds
L7	associated with the American recovery and reinvestment act of 2009,
L8	Public Law 111-5. These federal funds are temporary in nature. It
L9	is the intent of the legislature that when these temporary federal
20	funds are fully expended, the program funding levels and any state
21	employees supported by these temporary federal funds will not be
22	continued.
23	Sec. 210. (1) In addition to the funds appropriated in part 1,
24	there is appropriated an amount equal to any additional federal
2.5	funding awarded to this state through recalculation of formulas and
