3 PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

4 **GENERAL SECTIONS**

5 Sec. 201. In accordance with the provisions of section 30 of
6 article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending
7 from state resources in this appropriation act for the fiscal year
8 ending September 30, 2010 is \$0.00 and state appropriations paid to
9 local units of government are \$0.

10 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized
11 under this act and the departments, commissions, boards, offices,
12 and programs for which appropriations are made under this act are
13 subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101
14 to 18.1594.

15 Sec. 203. The line-item appropriations in part 1 financed by
16 federal funds designated as ARRA funding represent federal funds
17 associated with the American recovery and reinvestment act of 2009,
18 Public Law 111-5. These federal funds are temporary in nature. It
19 is the intent of the legislature that when these temporary federal
20 funds are fully expended, the program funding levels and any state
21 employees supported by these temporary federal funds will not be
22 continued.

23 Sec. 210. (1) In addition to the funds appropriated in part 1,
24 there is appropriated an amount equal to any additional federal
25 funding awarded to this state through recalculation of formulas and

1 under the redistribution provisions of the American recovery and
2 reinvestment act of 2009, Public Law 111-5.

3 (2) Within 30 days of receiving such an award, a department
4 shall report to the senate and house appropriations subcommittees,
5 senate and house fiscal agencies, state budget director, and the
6 governor on the amount of funds received and the purposes for which
7 they will be spent.

8 Sec. 211. The unexpended funds appropriated in part 1 and in
9 section 210 and any unencumbered or unallotted funds are carried
10 forward into the succeeding fiscal year. The following is in
11 compliance with section 451a(1) of the management and budget act,
12 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1451a:

13 (a) The purposes of the projects to be carried forward are to
14 protect and invest in the natural resources, infrastructure, and
15 people of the state of Michigan in accordance with the provisions
16 of the American recovery and reinvestment act of 2009, Public Law
17 111-5.

18 (b) The projects will be accomplished by state employees and
19 by contract.

20 (c) The total estimated cost of all projects is identified in
21 each line-item appropriation.

22 (d) The tentative completion date is September 30, 2012.

23 Sec. 212. (1) In a form and manner determined by the recipient
24 department, local governments and other eligible sub-recipients
25 receiving funds through this act shall comply with all requirements
26 corresponding to the receipt of funds, including, but not limited
27 to, any certifications, assurances, and accountability and

1 transparency provisions required in the American recovery and
2 reinvestment act of 2009, Public Law 111-5.

3 (2) Funds appropriated in part 1 may be transferred to sub-
4 recipient state departments or agencies in an interdepartmental
5 grant consistent with the requirements of the American recovery and
6 reinvestment act of 2009, Public Law 111-5.
