## **SENATE BILL No. 1095**

## January 27, 2010, Introduced by Senator McMANUS and referred to the Committee on Campaign and Election Oversight.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled

"Michigan election law,"

by amending section 644e (MCL 168.644e), as amended by 2003 PA 302.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 644e. Except as provided in section 642, an officer 2 required to be elected at the odd year general election shall be 3 nominated at the odd year primary election. Subject to section 382, 4 if IF a charter provides for nomination by caucus or by filing a 5 petition or affidavit directly for the general election, or 6 provides for the election at the primary of a candidate who 7 receives more than 50% of the votes cast for that office, the governing body by ordinance may provide for a caucus date, filing 8

date, or other provisions to the extent necessary to be consistent 1 with the odd year general election requirement of this act and the 2 3 intent of the charter provisions THE CANDIDATE FILING DEADLINE OR CERTIFICATION DEADLINE SHALL BE 4 P.M. ON THE TWELFTH TUESDAY 4 BEFORE THE ODD YEAR GENERAL ELECTION. IF A CHARTER PROVIDES FOR THE 5 ELECTION AT THE PRIMARY OF A CANDIDATE WHO RECEIVES MORE THAN 50% 6 OF THE VOTES CAST FOR THAT OFFICE, THE CANDIDATE FILING DEADLINE OR 7 CERTIFICATION DEADLINE SHALL BE 4 P.M. ON THE TWELFTH TUESDAY 8 BEFORE THE PRIMARY. 9
