

HOUSE BILL No. 4322

February 18, 2009, Introduced by Reps. Spade, Espinoza, Leland, Gonzales, Switalski, Terry Brown, Bauer, Booher and Ball and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 411u.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 411U. (1) A PERSON SENTENCED BY THE COURT TO PERFORM
2 COMMUNITY SERVICE WHO KNOWINGLY PROVIDES FALSE INFORMATION TO THE
3 COURT REGARDING HIS OR HER PERFORMANCE OF THAT COMMUNITY SERVICE IS
4 GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE
5 THAN 30 DAYS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500.00, OR BOTH.

6 (2) A PERSON WHO KNOWINGLY PROVIDES FALSE INFORMATION TO THE
7 COURT THAT A PERSON SENTENCED TO PERFORM COMMUNITY SERVICE HAS
8 COMPLIED WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THAT COMMUNITY SERVICE IS GUILTY
9 OF A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 30
10 DAYS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500.00, OR BOTH.

1 (3) THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT THE PERSON FROM BEING
2 CHARGED WITH, CONVICTED OF, OR SENTENCED FOR ANY OTHER VIOLATION OF
3 LAW ARISING OUT OF ACTIONS THAT CONSTITUTE A VIOLATION OF THIS
4 SECTION.

5 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
6 after the date it is enacted into law.
