NOT LATER THAN APRIL 1, 2010 OR AT A TIME CONSIDERED POSSIBLE BY THE DEPARTMENT, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL OPERATE AN 2 3 ELECTRONIC PAYMENT PROCESS WITH PARTICIPATING PROVIDER UTILITIES TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF LOW INCOME CUSTOMER ENERGY BILLS THAT 4 ARE SUBJECT TO SHUTOFF.
