Any person or police officer, violating or failing or 1 2 refusing to comply with any of the provisions of this act shall be 3 quilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall pay a fine not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$100.00, or shall be imprisoned in 4 5 the county jail for not exceeding 3 months, or both such fine and 6 imprisonment. Any person presenting a false claim, knowing it to be false, or receiving any money on such false claim, shall be quilty 8 of a misdemeanor and upon conviction, shall pay a fine of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$100.00, or shall be imprisoned in the 10 county jail for not exceeding 3 months, or both such fine and
