HOUSE BILL No. 4955

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled

"Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending sections 803e, 803i, 803j, 803k, and 803*l* (MCL 257.803e, 257.803i, 257.803j, 257.803k, and 257.803*l*), section 803e as amended by 2003 PA 30, section 803i as amended by 1998 PA 68, sections 803j and 803k as amended by 1999 PA 183, and section 803*l* as amended by 2000 PA 77.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 803e. (1) A person who has been a prisoner of war or a
 person whose spouse has been a prisoner of war may make application
 to the secretary of state for a special registration plate which
 THAT shall be inscribed with special identification numbers
 preceded by the letters "EX-POW" and shall have the words "ex prisoner of war" inscribed beneath the registration number.
 A person who was a member of the armed services during

1 World War I may make application to the secretary of state for a 2 special registration plate , which THAT shall be inscribed with 3 special identification numbers preceded by the letters "WWI" and 4 shall have the words "World War I veteran" inscribed beneath the 5 registration number.

6 (3) A person who was a member of the armed services during 1941, stationed at a United States military or naval establishment 7 at Pearl Harbor in the Hawaiian islands, and who survived the 8 9 attack by Japan on Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941 may make 10 application to the secretary of state for a special registration 11 plate - which THAT shall be inscribed with special identification 12 numbers and shall have the words "Pearl Harbor survivor" inscribed 13 beneath the registration number.

14 (4) A person who is a recipient of the purple heart medal may 15 make application to the secretary of state for a special registration plate which THAT shall be inscribed with special 16 17 identification numbers and shall have the words "combat wounded 18 veteran" inscribed beneath the registration number. In addition, 19 the special registration plate described under this subsection 20 shall be inscribed with a vignette of the official purple heart 21 medal.

(5) Application for a special registration plate shall be on a
form prescribed by the secretary of state, and shall be accompanied
by any proof of the applicant having been a prisoner of war, World
War I veteran, Pearl Harbor survivor, or recipient of the purple
heart medal that the secretary of state may require. The
application for a special registration plate shall also be

accompanied with payment of a \$5.00 service fee. THE SECRETARY OF
 STATE SHALL NOT CHARGE A SERVICE FEE FOR A SPECIAL REGISTRATION
 PLATE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION.

4 (6) Upon proper application, and payment of the \$5.00 service 5 fee, the secretary of state shall issue 1 or more special 6 registration plates for each applicant for use on a passenger 7 vehicle. A person who is disabled who makes application for a special registration plate under this section and who makes payment 8 9 of the \$5.00 service fee shall be issued a tab for persons with 10 disabilities as provided in section 803f for his or her special 11 registration plate. The secretary of state shall require the same 12 proof that the applicant is a disabled person as is required for issuance of a permanent windshield placard under section 675. One 13 14 person in any household is entitled to 1 special registration plate 15 issued under subsection (1) that is exempt from payment of the tax provided in section 801. The person who is issued an additional 16 17 special registration plate under subsection (1) shall be assessed 18 the applicable tax provided for in section 801. A person issued 1 19 or more special registration plates under subsection (2), (3), or 20 (4) shall be assessed the applicable tax provided in section 801.

(7) The use of a special registration plate on a vehicle other
than the vehicle for which the plate is issued, or by a person who
does not qualify under this section, is a misdemeanor.

(8) The special registration plate issued under this section
expires on the birthday of the vehicle owner in a year in which new
plates are issued by the secretary of state. Application for
renewal of the special registration plate shall be accompanied by a

\$5.00 service fee. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL NOT CHARGE A
 SERVICE FEE FOR A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE RENEWED UNDER THIS
 SUBSECTION. The applicant is not required to furnish the proof
 provided in subsection (5).

Sec. 803i. (1) A person who was or is a member of the national
guard may apply to the secretary of state for a special
registration plate - which THAT shall display an appropriate
vignette preceding the registration numbers and shall have the
words "national guard" inscribed beneath the registration numbers.

10 (2) A person who was or is a member of the military reserve 11 may apply to the secretary of state for a special registration 12 plate - which THAT shall display an appropriate vignette preceding 13 the registration numbers.

14 (3) A person who was a member of any branch of the armed 15 services of the United States, who has retired or been granted an 16 honorable discharge from that branch of the armed forces, and who 17 is not otherwise eligible for a special registration plate under 18 this act may apply to the secretary of state for a special 19 registration plate which THAT shall display an appropriate vignette 20 preceding the registration numbers.

(4) Application for a special registration plate shall be on a
form prescribed by the secretary of state and shall be accompanied
by any proof of the applicant being or having been a member of the
national guard or military reserve or a member of any branch of the
armed services of the United States as described in subsection (3)
that the secretary of state may require. The application for a
special registration plate shall also be accompanied with payment

of a \$5.00 service fee. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL NOT CHARGE A
 SERVICE FEE FOR A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE ISSUED UNDER THIS
 SECTION.

4 (5) Upon proper application, and payment of the \$5.00 service 5 fee, the secretary of state shall issue 1 or more special 6 registration plates for each applicant for use on a passenger vehicle. A person who is disabled who applies for a special 7 registration plate under this section and who pays the \$5.00 8 9 service fee shall be issued a tab for persons with disabilities as 10 provided in section 803f for his or her special registration plate. 11 The secretary of state shall require the same proof that the 12 applicant is a disabled person as is required for issuance of a permanent windshield placard under section 675. A person issued 1 13 14 or more special registration plates under subsection (1), (2), or 15 (3) shall be assessed the applicable tax provided in section 801.

16 (6) The use of a special registration plate on a vehicle other
17 than the vehicle for which the plate is issued, or by a person who
18 does not qualify under this section, is a misdemeanor.

(7) The special registration plate issued under this section 19 20 shall expire EXPIRES on the birthday of the vehicle owner. When new plates are issued by the secretary of state, application for 21 22 renewal of the special registration plate shall be accompanied by a 23 \$5.00 service fee. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL NOT CHARGE A 24 SERVICE FEE FOR A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE RENEWED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION. The applicant shall not be required to furnish the 25 proof provided in subsection (4) WITH AN APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF 26 27 THE SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE.

Sec. 803j. (1) A person who was a member of the armed services
 or a person whose spouse was a member of the armed forces during
 the Korean War may make application to the secretary of state for a
 special registration plate - which THAT shall display an
 appropriate vignette preceding the registration numbers and shall
 have the word "veteran" inscribed beneath the registration numbers.

(2) Application for a special registration plate shall be on a 7 form prescribed by the secretary of state, and shall be accompanied 8 by any proof of the applicant or the applicant's spouse having been 9 10 a Korean War veteran that the secretary of state may require. The 11 application for a special registration plate shall also be 12 accompanied with payment of a \$5.00 service fee. THE SECRETARY OF 13 STATE SHALL NOT CHARGE A SERVICE FEE FOR A SPECIAL PLATE ISSUED 14 UNDER THIS SECTION.

15 (3) Upon proper application, and payment of the \$5.00 service fee, the secretary of state shall issue 1 or more special 16 17 registration plates for each applicant for use on a passenger 18 vehicle. A person who is disabled who makes application for a special registration plate under this section and who makes payment 19 20 of the \$5.00 service fee shall be issued a tab for persons with disabilities as provided in section 803f for his or her special 21 registration plate. The secretary of state shall require the same 22 proof that the applicant is a disabled person as is required for 23 24 issuance of a permanent windshield placard under section 675. A person issued 1 or more special registration plates under 25 26 subsection (1) shall be assessed the applicable tax provided in 27 section 801.

THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL NOT CHARGE A 8 9 SERVICE FEE FOR A SPECIAL PLATE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION. The 10 applicant shall not be required to furnish the proof provided in 11 subsection (2).

Sec. 803k. (1) A person who was a member of the armed services during the Vietnam War or a person whose spouse was a member of the armed services during the Vietnam War may make application to the secretary of state for a special registration plate , which THAT shall display an appropriate vignette preceding the registration numbers and shall have the word "veteran" inscribed beneath the registration numbers.

19 (2) Application for a special registration plate shall be on a 20 form prescribed by the secretary of state, and shall be accompanied by any proof of the applicant or applicant's spouse having been a 21 Vietnam War veteran that the secretary of state may require. The 22 application for a special registration plate shall also be 23 24 accompanied with payment of a \$5.00 service fee. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL NOT CHARGE A SERVICE FEE FOR A SPECIAL REGISTRATION 25 26 PLATE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION.

(3) Upon proper application, and payment of the \$5.00 service

fee, the secretary of state shall issue 1 or more special 1 2 registration plates for each applicant for use on a passenger vehicle. A person who is disabled who makes application for a 3 4 special registration plate under this section and who makes payment 5 of the \$5.00 service fee shall be issued a tab for persons with 6 disabilities as provided in section 803f for his or her special registration plate. The secretary of state shall require the same 7 proof that the applicant is a disabled person as is required for 8 9 issuance of a permanent windshield placard under section 675. A 10 person issued 1 or more special registration plates under 11 subsection (1) shall be assessed the applicable tax provided in 12 section 801.

13 (4) The use of a special registration plate on a vehicle other

Sec. 803*l*. (1) A person who was a member of the armed services during World War II or a person whose spouse was a member of the armed services during World War II may make application to the secretary of state for a special registration plate , which THAT

shall display an appropriate vignette preceding the registration
 numbers and shall have the word "veteran" inscribed beneath the
 registration numbers.

(2) Application for a special registration plate shall be on a 4 form prescribed by the secretary of state, and shall be accompanied 5 by any proof of the applicant or applicant's spouse having been a 6 World War II veteran that the secretary of state may require. The 7 application for a special registration plate shall also be 8 9 accompanied with payment of a \$5.00 service fee. THE SECRETARY OF 10 STATE SHALL NOT CHARGE A SERVICE FEE FOR A SPECIAL REGISTRATION 11 PLATE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION.

12 (3) Upon proper application, and payment of the \$5.00 service fee, the secretary of state shall issue 1 special registration 13 plate for each applicant for use on a passenger vehicle. A person 14 15 who is disabled who makes application for a special registration plate under this section and who makes payment of the \$5.00 service 16 17 fee shall be issued a tab for persons with disabilities as provided 18 in section 803f for his or her special registration plate.
