

HOUSE BILL No. 5130

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
by amending section 430a (MCL 750.430a), as added by 1998 PA 110.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 430a. (1) An individual shall not intentionally engage in
2 or attempt to engage in human cloning.

3 ~~———(2) Subsection (1) THIS SUBSECTION~~ does not prohibit
4 scientific research or cell-based therapies not specifically
5 prohibited by ~~that~~ UNDER THIS subsection.

6 (2) AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL NOT INTENTIONALLY TRANSPORT, ATTEMPT
7 TO TRANSPORT, OR CAUSE TO BE TRANSPORTED INTO THIS STATE A HUMAN
8 EMBRYO CREATED THROUGH HUMAN CLONING.

9 (3) An individual who violates ~~subsection (1) THIS SECTION~~ is

1 guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than 10
2 years or a fine of not more than \$10,000,000.00, or both.

3 (4) As used in this section, "human cloning" means that term
4 as defined in section 16274 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368,
5 MCL 333.16274.
