## SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4359

As amended June 29, 2011

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 803i (MCL 257.803i), as amended by 1998 PA 68.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 803i. (1) A person who was or is a member of the national
- 2 guard may apply to the secretary of state for a special
- 3 registration plate , which THAT shall display an appropriate
- 4 vignette preceding the registration numbers and shall have the
- 5 words "national guard" inscribed beneath the registration numbers <<FOR PASSENGER VEHICLES ONLY>>.
- 6 (2) A person who was or is a member of the military reserve
- 7 may apply to the secretary of state for a special registration
- 8 plate , which THAT shall display an appropriate vignette preceding
- 9 the registration numbers.

- 1 (3) A person who was a member of any branch of the armed
- 2 services of the United States, who has retired or been granted an
- 3 honorable discharge from that branch of the armed forces, and who
- 4 is not otherwise eligible for a special registration plate under
- 5 this act may apply to the secretary of state for a special
- 6 registration plate which THAT shall display an appropriate vignette
- 7 preceding the registration numbers.
- 8 (4) Application for a special registration plate shall be on a
- 9 form prescribed by the secretary of state and shall be accompanied
- 10 by any proof of the applicant being or having been a member of the
- 11 national guard or military reserve or a member of any branch of the
- 12 armed services of the United States as described in subsection (3)
- 13 that the secretary of state may require. The application for a
- 14 special registration plate shall also be accompanied with payment
- 15 of a \$5.00 service fee.
- 16 (5) Upon proper application and payment of the \$5.00 service
- 17 fee, the secretary of state shall issue 1 or more special
- 18 registration plates for each applicant for use on a passenger
- 19 vehicle OR, FOR THE PURPOSES OF SUBSECTION (1) OR (3), FOR USE ON A
- 20 MOTORCYCLE. A person who is disabled who applies for a special
- 21 registration plate under this section and who pays the \$5.00
- 22 service fee shall be issued a tab for persons with disabilities as
- 23 provided in section 803f for his or her special registration plate.
- 24 The secretary of state shall require the same proof that the
- 25 applicant is a disabled person as is required for issuance of a
- 26 permanent windshield placard under section 675. A person issued 1
- 27 or more special registration plates under subsection (1), (2), or

- 1 (3) shall be assessed the applicable tax provided in section 801.
- 2 (6) The use of a special registration plate on a vehicle other
- 3 than the vehicle for which the plate is issued, or by a person who
- 4 does not qualify under this section, is a misdemeanor.
- 5 (7) The special registration plate issued under this section
- 6 shall expire on the birthday of the vehicle owner. When new plates
- 7 are issued by the secretary of state, application for renewal of
- 8 the special registration plate shall be accompanied by a \$5.00
- 9 service fee. The applicant shall not be required to furnish the
- 10 proof provided in subsection (4).
