HOUSE BILL No. 5342

February 2, 2012, Introduced by Reps. Haines, Horn, Kowall, Crawford, Price, Shirkey, Franz, Opsommer, Roy Schmidt and Cavanagh and referred to the Committee on Energy and Technology.

A bill to amend 1929 PA 152, entitled

"An act to provide for the state-owned and operated Michigan public safety communications system for police and public safety purposes; to provide for acquisition, construction, implementation, operation, and maintenance of the property and equipment necessary to operate the system; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies and officials,"

by amending the title and sections 1, 2, and 3 (MCL 28.281, 28.282, and 28.283), as amended by 1996 PA 538.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

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TITLE

An act to provide for the state-owned and operated Michigan public safety communications system; for police and public safety purposes; to provide for acquisition, construction, implementation, operation, and maintenance of the property and equipment necessary to operate the system; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies and officials. Sec. 1. The Michigan public safety communications system is an
 800-megahertz radio system and telecommunication network within the
 department of state police TECHNOLOGY, MANAGEMENT, AND BUDGET and
 includes all real and personal property, towers, buildings,
 equipment, and other related facilities and fixtures necessary for
 the operation and maintenance of the system.

7 Sec. 2. (1) The director of the department of state police and
8 the director of the department of TECHNOLOGY, management, and
9 budget are IS responsible for the construction, implementation,
10 operation, and maintenance of the Michigan public safety
11 communications system.

12 (2) In siting the buildings and equipment necessary to implement the Michigan public safety communications system, the 13 14 director of the department of state police TECHNOLOGY, MANAGEMENT, AND BUDGET shall locate the system, AND a local unit of government 15 with zoning authority shall be notified of a site selected in their 16 17 jurisdiction and the requirements necessary for a site. If the 18 selected site does not comply with zoning, the local unit shall 19 have HAS 30 days from the date of notification to grant a special 20 use permit or propose an equivalent site. If the local unit does 21 not grant a special use permit within the 30 day period, or a 22 proposed alternate site does not meet the siting requirements, the 23 department may proceed with construction.

Sec. 3. (1) The department of state police shall broadcast all police dispatches and reports which THAT have a reasonable relation to or connection with the apprehension of criminals, the prevention of crime, or the maintenance of peace, order, and public safety in

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1 this state.

(2) The director of the department of state police TECHNOLOGY,
MANAGEMENT, AND BUDGET may authorize any governmental public safety
agency PERSON to utilize the Michigan public safety communications
system FOR COMMUNICATIONS CONSISTENT WITH RULES ISSUED BY THE
FEDERAL COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION OR TO UTILIZE THE MICHIGAN PUBLIC
SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM FOR COLOCATIONS.

8 (3) ALL COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH PLANNING, INSTALLING, AND 9 MAINTAINING COLOCATION EQUIPMENT ARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE 10 PERSON REQUESTING PERMISSION FOR COLOCATION. COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH 11 COLOCATING ON THE MICHIGAN PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM PAID 12 BY A PERSON REQUESTING PERMISSION TO COLOCATE SHALL BE COMPARABLE 13 TO THE COSTS CHARGED TO OTHER PERSONS REQUESTING TO COLOCATE.

14 (4) THE DEPARTMENT OF TECHNOLOGY, MANAGEMENT, AND BUDGET SHALL
15 USE ANY MONEY COLLECTED FROM LEASING THE MICHIGAN PUBLIC SAFETY
16 COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM FOR THE PAYMENT OF DEBT SERVICE FOR BONDS
17 THAT FINANCE THE CONSTRUCTION OR MAINTENANCE OF THE MICHIGAN PUBLIC
18 SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM.

19 (5) THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TECHNOLOGY, MANAGEMENT, 20 AND BUDGET MAY DENY A PERSON PERMISSION TO INSTALL, ATTACH, OR CONTINUE TO COLOCATE EQUIPMENT TO A TOWER CONSTRUCTED UNDER THIS 21 ACT IF THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TECHNOLOGY, MANAGEMENT, 22 AND BUDGET OR HIS OR HER DESIGNEE DETERMINES THAT THE INSTALLATION, 23 ATTACHMENT, OR CONTINUED COLOCATION WILL INTERFERE WITH THE OPTIMUM 24 OPERATION OF THE MICHIGAN PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM OR 25 26 ANY PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS COLOCATED ON A TOWER.

27 (6) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:

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(A) "COLOCATE" MEANS TO PLACE OR INSTALL WIRELESS 1 2 COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT OR NETWORK COMPONENTS USED IN THE PROVISION OF WIRELESS COMMUNICATIONS SERVICES, INCLUDING, BUT NOT 3 4 LIMITED TO, ANTENNAS, TRANSMITTERS, RECEIVERS, BASE STATIONS, EQUIPMENT SHELTERS, CABINETS, EMERGENCY GENERATORS, POWER SUPPLY 5 CABLING, AND COAXIAL AND FIBER OPTIC CABLE, ON OR IN THE REAL OR 6 PERSONAL PROPERTY, TOWERS, BUILDINGS, EQUIPMENT, OR OTHER RELATED 7 FACILITIES AND FIXTURES USED IN THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF 8 THE MICHIGAN PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM. 9

10 (B) "PERSON" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL, CORPORATION, PARTNERSHIP,
11 ASSOCIATION, GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY, OR ANY OTHER LEGAL ENTITY.

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
