18	Sec. 301. (1) Funds appropriated in part 1 to the department
19	of state police for grants to local law enforcement agencies shall
20	be used by local law enforcement agencies throughout the state to
21	assist local communities in paying the costs of employing full-time
22	and part-time officers who are dedicated to keeping communities
23	safe. Funding is to be used for hiring additional police officers,
24	purchasing necessary technology and equipment, and hiring civilian

25 staff to support local law enforcement operations.

- 5 (3) Of the \$70,000,000.00 awarded in fiscal year 2011-2012,
- 6 \$35,000,000.00 shall be awarded to law enforcement agencies within
- 7 communities under financial review or with financial managers in
- 8 place. The \$35,000,000.00 shall be divided according to crime rates
- 9 and population. The remaining \$35,000,000.00 shall be dedicated to
- 10 statewide public safety staff at the discretion of the department
- 11 of state police.
- 12 (4) These funds are designated as work project appropriations
- 13 and shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal year and shall
- 14 continue to be available for expenditure for the purposes described
- 15 in this section.
