## **HOUSE BILL No. 5590**

May 1, 2012, Introduced by Reps. Graves, Tyler, Somerville, Kowall, McMillin, Denby, Rendon, LaFontaine, Wayne Schmidt, Nesbitt, Horn, Hughes, Gilbert, Bumstead, Heise, Hooker, Yonker, Jenkins and Kurtz and referred to the Committee on Military and Veterans Affairs and Homeland Security.

A bill to amend 1968 PA 330, entitled "Private security business and security alarm act," by amending section 6 (MCL 338.1056), as amended by 2002 PA 473.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 6. (1) The department shall issue a license to conduct
- 2 business as a security alarm system contractor or a private
- 3 security guard, private security police, or to a private security
- 4 guard business, if it is satisfied that the applicant, is a sole
- 5 proprietorship, or if a firm, partnership, company, limited
- 6 liability company, or corporation the sole or principal license
- 7 holder IF THE APPLICANT is an individual, who OR THE INDIVIDUAL WHO
- 8 IS THE SOLE OR PRINCIPAL LICENSE HOLDER OF THE APPLICANT IF THE
- 9 APPLICANT IS NOT AN INDIVIDUAL, meets all of the following
- 10 qualifications:

- 1 (a) Is not less than 25 years of age.
- 2 (b) Has a high school education or its equivalent.
- 3 (c) In the case of a licensee under this section IF THE
- 4 APPLICANT'S LICENSE IS ISSUED after March 28, 2001, has not been
- 5 under any sentence, including parole, probation, or actual
- 6 incarceration, for the commission CONVICTED of a felony.
- 7 (d) In the case of a person licensed under this section IF THE
- 8 APPLICANT'S LICENSE WAS ISSUED on or before March 28, 2001, has not
- 9 been under any sentence, including parole, probation, or actual
- 10 incarceration, for the commission WAS NOT CONVICTED of a felony
- 11 within 5 years before IN THE 5-YEAR PERIOD PRECEDING the date of
- 12 application.
- 13 (e) Has WAS not been convicted of an offense listed in section
- 14 10(1)(c) within 5 years before IN THE 5-YEAR PERIOD PRECEDING the
- 15 date of application.
- 16 (f) Has not been dishonorably discharged from a branch of the
- 17 United States military service.
- 18 (g) In the case of an IF THE applicant IS APPLYING for a
- 19 private security guard or agency license, has been lawfully engaged
- 20 in 1 or more MEETS ANY of the following:
- 21 (i) In—WAS ENGAGED IN the private security guard or agency
- 22 business on his or her own account in another state for a period of
- 23 not less than AT LEAST 3 years.
- 24 (ii) In WAS ENGAGED IN the private security guard or agency
- 25 business for a period of not less than AT LEAST 4 years as an
- 26 employee of the holder of a certificate of authority to conduct a
- 27 private security guard or agency business and has had experience

- 1 reasonably equivalent to not less than AT LEAST 4 years of full-
- 2 time guard work in a supervisory capacity with rank above that of
- 3 patrolman.
- 4 (iii) In WAS EMPLOYED IN law enforcement employment as a
- 5 certified police officer on a full-time basis for not less than AT
- 6 LEAST 4 years for a city, county, or state government —or for the
- 7 United States government.
- 8 (iv) In WAS ENGAGED IN the private security guard or agency
- 9 business as an employee or on his or her own account or as a
- 10 security administrator in private business for not less than AT
- 11 LEAST 2 years on a full-time basis, and is a graduate with a
- 12 baccalaureate degree or its equivalent in the field of police
- 13 administration or industrial security from an accredited college or
- 14 university.
- 15 (v) SERVED AS A MILITARY POLICE OFFICER, OR IN AN EQUIVALENT
- 16 LAW ENFORCEMENT POSITION, FOR AT LEAST 2 YEARS WHILE ON ACTIVE DUTY
- 17 AS A MEMBER OF THE ARMED FORCES AND WAS HONORABLY DISCHARGED FROM
- 18 THAT MILITARY SERVICE. AS USED IN THIS SUBPARAGRAPH, "ARMED FORCES"
- 19 MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 2 OF THE VETERAN RIGHT TO
- 20 EMPLOYMENT SERVICES ACT, 1994 PA 39, MCL 35.1092.
- 21 (h) In the case of an IF THE applicant IS APPLYING for a
- 22 security alarm system contractor license, has been lawfully engaged
- 23 in either or both of the following:
- (i) The A security alarm system contractor business on his or
- 25 her own account for a period of not less than 3 years.
- 26 (ii) The—A security alarm system contractor business for a
- 27 period of not less than 4 years as an employee of the holder of a

- 1 certificate of authority to conduct a security alarm system
- 2 contractor business, and has had experience reasonably equivalent
- 3 to at least 4 years of full-time work in a supervisory capacity or
- 4 passes a written exam administered by the department designed to
- 5 measure his or her knowledge and training in security alarm
- 6 systems.
- 7 (i) Has posted with PROVIDED the department a THE bond
- 8 provided for in this act.OR SURETY REQUIRED UNDER SECTION 9.
- 9 (j) Has not been adjudged insane, unless HE OR SHE HAS BEEN
- 10 ADJUDGED restored to sanity by court order.
- 11 (k) Does not have IS NOT SUBJECT TO any outstanding warrants
- 12 for his or her arrest.
- 13 (2) In the case of a sole proprietorship, firm, partnership,
- 14 company, or corporation—IF A PERSON now doing or seeking to do
- 15 business in this state IS APPLYING FOR A LICENSE UNDER THIS
- 16 SECTION, the resident manager shall comply with the applicable
- 17 qualifications of this section.
