(MCL 400.1 to 400.119b) by adding section 56j.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 56J. (1) WHEN AN INDIVIDUAL APPLIES FOR ASSISTANCE UNDER
- 2 THIS ACT, IF THE INDIVIDUAL HAS A SCHOOL-AGED CHILD, THE INDIVIDUAL
- 3 SHALL SIGN AN AFFIDAVIT STATING THAT THE CHILD IS ENROLLED IN AND
- 4 ATTENDING SCHOOL AND HAS AN ATTENDANCE RATE OF NOT LESS THAN 80%
- 5 FOR THE CURRENT SCHOOL YEAR, NOT INCLUDING ILLNESS- OR INJURY-
- 6 RELATED ABSENCES. THE AFFIDAVIT SHALL INCLUDE THE CHILD'S NAME, THE
- 7 NAME OF THE SCHOOL THE CHILD ATTENDS, AND THE NAME OF THE SCHOOL
- 8 DISTRICT IN WHICH THE SCHOOL IS LOCATED.
  - (2) THE DEPARTMENT MAY REQUIRE CONSENT TO RELEASE THE CHILD'S

- 17 (5) AS A CONDITION OF ELIGIBILITY FOR ASSISTANCE UNDER THIS
- 18 ACT, IF AN INDIVIDUAL HAS A SCHOOL-AGED CHILD ATTENDING SCHOOL
- 19 OUTSIDE OF THE HOME, THAT INDIVIDUAL MUST ATTEND NOT FEWER THAN 1
- 20 PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCE FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR IN WHICH HE OR SHE
- 21 RECEIVES ASSISTANCE UNDER THIS ACT.
