The prosecuting attorney may , under the direction of the court, procure such THE assistance in the trial of any person 3 4 charged with a felony as he may deem OR SHE CONSIDERS necessary. 5 for the trial thereof, and the prosecuting attorney may, under the 6 direction of the court, in case of disability of the prosecuting attorney, THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY MAY appoint an assistant to 7 perform his OR HER duties during A PERIOD WHEN the disability of 8 9 the prosecuting attorney, and such PROSECUTING ATTORNEY IS UNABLE
