

SENATE BILL No. 1357

November 8, 2012, Introduced by Senator JONES and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled "The code of criminal procedure," by amending section 17f of chapter XVII (MCL 777.17f), as amended by 2006 PA 404.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

CHAPTER XVII

Sec. 17f. This chapter applies to the following felonies enumerated in chapters 760 to 799 of the Michigan Compiled Laws:
