A joint resolution proposing an amendment to the state constitution of 1963, by adding section 28 to article I, to create a right to collective bargaining.

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the state of Michigan, That the following amendment to the state constitution of 1963, to create a right to collective bargaining , is proposed, agreed to, and submitted to the people of the state:

ARTICLE I

SEC. 28. EVERY PERSON SHALL HAVE THE RIGHT TO FORM, JOIN, OR ASSIST LABOR ORGANIZATIONS AND TO BARGAIN COLLECTIVELY THROUGH REPRESENTATIVES CHOSEN BY THE MEMBERS OF THE LABOR ORGANIZATIONS AS
