

# HOUSE BILL No. 5839

September 23, 2014, Introduced by Rep. Kesto and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled  
"Public health code,"  
by amending section 16107 (MCL 333.16107).

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           Sec. 16107. (1) **"PERMANENT REVOCATION" MEANS THE PERMANENT**  
2 **CANCELLATION OR WITHDRAWAL OF A LICENSE, REGISTRATION, OR**  
3 **AUTHORIZATION TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF A HEALTH PROFESSION**  
4 **UNDER THIS ARTICLE THAT IS ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT, BOARD, OR TASK**  
5 **FORCE.**

6           (2) ~~(1)~~-"Probation" means a sanction ~~which~~ **THAT** permits a  
7 board to evaluate over a period of time a licensee's **OR**  
8 **REGISTRANT'S** fitness to continue to practice under a license **OR**  
9 **REGISTRATION.**

10           (3) ~~(2)~~-"Public member" means a member of the general public

1 who is not a licensee or registrant, ~~under this article,~~ is a  
2 resident of this state, is not less than 18 years of age, and does  
3 not have a material financial interest in the provision of health  
4 services and has not had ~~such an~~ **A MATERIAL FINANCIAL** interest  
5 within the 12 months before appointment.

6 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days  
7 after the date it is enacted into law.

8 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect  
9 unless all of the following bills of the 97th Legislature are  
10 enacted into law:
