HOUSE BILL No. 4634

April 25, 2013, Introduced by Rep. Schmidt and referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 226 (MCL 257.226), as amended by 2004 PA 163.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 226. (1) A vehicle registration issued by the secretary of state expires on the owner's birthday, unless another expiration date is provided for under this act or unless the registration is for the following vehicles, in which case registration expires on the last day of February:AS FOLLOWS:
 - (a) A-FOR A commercial vehicle except for a commercial vehicle issued a registration under the international registration plan or a pickup truck or van owned by an individual, THE LAST DAY OF FEBRUARY.
 - (b) Except for a trailer or semitrailer issued a registration

- 1 under the international registration plan, a trailer or semitrailer
- 2 owned by a business, corporation, or person other than an
- 3 individual; or a pole trailer; JANUARY 1.
- 4 (2) Until February 1, 2005, the expiration date for a
- 5 registration issued for a motorcycle is March 31. Beginning
- 6 February 1, 2005, the THE expiration date for a registration issued
- 7 for a motorcycle is the motorcycle owner's birthday.
- 8 (3) The expiration date for a registration bearing the letters
- 9 "SEN" or "REP" is February 1.
- 10 (4) In the case of a vehicle owned by a business, corporation,
- 11 or an owner other than an individual, the secretary of state may
- 12 assign or reassign the expiration date of the registration.
- 13 (5) The secretary of state shall do all of the following:
- 14 (a) After the October 1 immediately preceding the year
- 15 designated on the registration, issue a registration upon
- 16 application and payment of the proper fee for a commercial vehicle,
- 17 other than a pickup or van owned by an individual +-or FOR a
- 18 trailer owned by a business, corporation, or person other than an
- 19 individual.
- 20 (b) Beginning 60 days before the expiration date assigned on
- 21 an international registration plan registration plate, issue a
- 22 registration under section 801g upon application and payment of the
- 23 proper apportioned fee for a commercial vehicle engaged in
- 24 interstate commerce.
- 25 (c) Beginning 45 days before the owner's birthday and 120 days
- 26 before the expiration date assigned by the secretary of state,
- 27 issue a registration for a vehicle other than those designated in

- 1 subsection (1)(a) or (b). However, if an owner whose registration
- 2 period begins 45 days before his or her birthday will be out of the
- 3 THIS state during the 45 days immediately preceding expiration of a
- 4 registration or for other good cause shown cannot apply for a
- 5 renewal registration within the 45-day period, application for a
- 6 renewal registration may be made not more than 6 months before
- 7 expiration.
- 8 (6) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the
- 9 secretary of state, upon application and payment of the proper fee,
- 10 shall issue a registration for a vehicle or a motorcycle to a
- 11 resident that shall expire EXPIRES on the owner's birthday. If the
- 12 owner's next birthday is at least 6 months but not more than 12
- 13 months in the future, the owner shall receive a registration valid
- 14 until the owner's next birthday. If the owner's next birthday is
- 15 less than 6 months in the future, the owner shall receive a
- 16 registration valid until the owner's birthday following the owner's
- 17 next birthday. The tax required under this act for a registration
- 18 described in this subsection shall be either of the following:
- 19 (a) For an original registration, the tax shall bear the same
- 20 relationship to the tax required under section 801 for a 12-month
- 21 registration as the length of the registration bears to 12 months.
- 22 (b) For a renewal of a registration, either of the following:
- (i) For a registration that is for at least 6 months but not
- 24 more than 12 months, the same amount as for 12 months.
- 25 (ii) For a renewal of a registration that is for more than 12
- 26 months, 2 times the amount for 12 months.
- 27 Partial months shall be ARE considered as whole months in the

- 1 calculation of the required tax and in the determination of the
- 2 length of time between the application for a registration and the
- 3 owner's next birthday. The tax required for that registration shall
- 4 be rounded off to whole dollars as provided in section 801.
- 5 (7) A certificate of title shall remain REMAINS valid until
- 6 canceled by the secretary of state for cause or upon a transfer of
- 7 an interest shown on the certificate of title.
- 8 (8) The secretary of state, upon request, shall issue special
- 9 registration for commercial vehicles, valid for 6 months after the
- 10 date of issue, if the full registration fee exceeds \$50.00, on the
- 11 payment of 1/2 the full registration fee and a service charge as
- 12 enumerated in UNDER section 802(1).
- 13 (9) The secretary of state may issue a special registration
- 14 for each of the following:
- 15 (a) A new vehicle purchased or leased outside of this state
- 16 and delivered in this state to the purchaser or lessee by the
- 17 manufacturer of that vehicle for removal to a place outside of this
- 18 state, if a certification is made that the vehicle will be
- 19 primarily used, stored, and registered outside of this state and
- 20 will not be returned to this state by the purchaser or lessee for
- 21 use or storage.
- 22 (b) A vehicle purchased or leased in this state and delivered
- 23 to the purchaser or lessee by a dealer or by the owner of the
- 24 vehicle for removal to a place outside of this state, if a
- 25 certification is made that the vehicle will be primarily used,
- 26 stored, and registered outside of this state and will not be
- 27 returned to this state by the purchaser or lessee for use or

- 1 storage.
- 2 (10) A special registration issued under subsection (9) is
- 3 valid for not more than 14 days after the date of issuance, and a
- 4 fee shall be collected for each special registration as provided in
- 5 section 802(3). The special registration may be in the A form
- 6 determined by the secretary of state. If a dealer makes a retail
- 7 sale or lease of a vehicle to a purchaser or lessee who is
- 8 qualified and eligible to obtain a special registration, the dealer
- 9 shall apply for the special registration for the purchaser or
- 10 lessee. If a person other than a dealer sells or leases a vehicle
- 11 to a purchaser or lessee who is qualified and eligible to obtain a
- 12 special registration, the purchaser or lessee shall appear in
- 13 person, or by a person exercising the purchaser's or lessee's power
- 14 of attorney, at an office of the secretary of state and furnish a
- 15 certification that the person is the bona fide purchaser or lessee
- 16 or that the person has granted the power of attorney, together with
- 17 other forms required for the issuance of the special registration
- 18 and provide the secretary of state with proof that the vehicle is
- 19 covered by a Michigan no-fault insurance policy issued pursuant to
- 20 section 3101 of the insurance code of 1956, 1956 PA 218, MCL
- 21 500.3101, or proof that the vehicle is covered by a policy of
- 22 insurance issued by an insurer pursuant to section 3163 of the
- 23 insurance code of 1956, 1956 PA 218, MCL 500.3163. The
- 24 certification required in this subsection shall contain all of the
- 25 following:
- 26 (a) The address of the purchaser or lessee.
- (b) A statement that the vehicle is purchased or leased for

- 1 registration outside of this state.
- 2 (c) A statement that the vehicle shall be primarily used,
- 3 stored, and registered outside of this state.
- 4 (d) The name of the jurisdiction in which the vehicle is to be
- 5 registered.
- 6 (e) Other information requested by the secretary of state.
- 7 (11) Upon request, the secretary of state may issue a
- 8 registration valid for 6 months after the date of issuance for use
- 9 on a trailer or semitrailer weighing 1,500 pounds or less and that
- 10 is used for recreational purposes, upon payment of 1/2 the full
- 11 registration fee imposed under section 801(1)(l). This subsection
- 12 does not apply after October 1, 2003.
- 13 (11) (12) In the case of a commercial vehicle, trailer, or
- 14 semitrailer issued a registration under the international
- 15 registration plan, the secretary of state in mutual agreement with
- 16 the owner may assign or reassign the expiration date of the
- 17 registration. However, the expiration date agreed to shall be
- 18 either March 31, June 30, September 30, or December 31. Renewals
- 19 expiring on or after September 30, 1993 shall be for a minimum of
- 20 at least 12 months if there is a change in the established
- 21 expiration date.
- 22 (12) (13) The expiration date for a multiyear registration
- 23 issued for a leased vehicle shall be IS the date the lease expires,
- 24 but shall not be for a period longer than 24 months.
