## **HOUSE BILL No. 5159**

November 14, 2013, Introduced by Reps. McMillin, Farrington, Zorn, Rogers, Foster, Haugh, Somerville, Lauwers, Daley, Rendon, Geiss, McBroom and Goike and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending sections 12603 and 12905 (MCL 333.12603 and 333.12905), as amended by 2009 PA 188.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 12603. (1) An—EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS
- 2 SECTION, AN individual shall not smoke in a public place or at a
- 3 meeting of a public body, and a state or local governmental agency
- 4 or the person who owns, operates, manages, or is in control of a
  - public place shall make a reasonable effort to prohibit individuals
  - from smoking in a public place.
  - (2) The EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, THE
- 8 owner, operator, manager, or person having control of a public
- 9 place, a food service establishment, or a casino subject to section

- 1 12606b shall do all of the following:
- 2 (a) Clearly and conspicuously post "no smoking" signs or the
- 3 international "no smoking" symbol at the entrances to and in every
- 4 building or other area where smoking is prohibited under this act.
- 5 (b) Remove all ashtrays and other smoking paraphernalia from
- 6 anywhere smoking is prohibited under this act.
- 7 (c) Inform individuals smoking in violation of this act that
- 8 they are in violation of state law and subject to penalties.
- 9 (d) If applicable, refuse to serve an individual smoking in
- 10 violation of this act.
- 11 (e) Ask an individual smoking in violation of this act to
- 12 refrain from smoking and, if the individual continues to smoke in
- 13 violation of this act, ask him or her to leave the public place,
- 14 food service establishment, or nonsmoking area of the casino.
- 15 (3) The EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, THE
- 16 owner, operator, manager, or person in control of a hotel, motel,
- 17 or other lodging facility shall comply with subsection (2) and
- 18 section 12606. It is an affirmative defense to a prosecution or
- 19 civil or administrative action for a violation of this section that
- 20 the owner, operator, manager, or person in control of a hotel,
- 21 motel, or other lodging facility where smoking is prohibited under
- 22 this section made a good faith effort to prohibit smoking by
- 23 complying with subsection (2). To assert the affirmative defense
- 24 under this subsection, the owner, operator, manager, or person
- 25 shall file a sworn affidavit setting forth his or her efforts to
- 26 prohibit smoking and his or her actions of compliance with
- 27 subsection (2).

- 1 (4) This section may be referred to as the "Dr. Ron Davis
- 2 Law".
- 3 (5) THE OWNER, OPERATOR, MANAGER, OR PERSON IN CONTROL OF A
- 4 PUBLIC PLACE THAT IS ALSO A COMMERCIAL PROPERTY MAY ALLOW SMOKING
- 5 IN AN AREA OF THE COMMERCIAL PROPERTY THAT IS LESS THAN 50%
- 6 ENCLOSED. AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION, "COMMERCIAL PROPERTY" MEANS
- 7 THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 2 OF THE COMMERCIAL REHABILITATION
- 8 ACT, 2005 PA 210, MCL 207.842.
- 9 Sec. 12905. (1) An—EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS
- 10 SUBSECTION, AN individual shall not smoke in a food service
- 11 establishment, and the person who owns, operates, manages, or is in
- 12 control of a food service establishment shall make reasonable
- 13 effort to prohibit individuals from smoking in a food service
- 14 establishment. A FOOD SERVICE ESTABLISHMENT MAY ALLOW SMOKING IN AN
- 15 AREA OF THE FOOD SERVICE ESTABLISHMENT THAT IS LESS THAN 50%
- 16 ENCLOSED.
- 17 (2) In addition to a food service establishment that provides
- 18 its own seating, subsection (1) applies to a food service
- 19 establishment or group of food service establishments that are
- 20 located in a shopping mall in which the seating for the food
- 21 service establishment or group of food service establishments is
- 22 provided or maintained, or both, by the person who owns or operates
- 23 the shopping mall.
- 24 (3) The director, an authorized representative of the
- 25 director, or a representative of a local health department to which
- 26 the director has delegated responsibility for enforcement of this
- 27 part shall inspect each food service establishment that is subject

- 1 to this section. The inspecting entity shall determine compliance
- 2 with this section during each inspection.
- 3 (4) Within 5 days after receipt of a written complaint of
- 4 violation of this section, a local health department shall
- 5 investigate the complaint to determine compliance. If a violation
- 6 of this section is identified and not corrected as ordered by the
- 7 local health department within 2 days after receipt of the order by
- 8 the food service establishment, the local health officer may issue
- 9 an order to cease food service operations until compliance with
- 10 this section is achieved.
- 11 (5) A food service establishment THAT IS SUBJECT TO THIS
- 12 SECTION shall comply with sections 12603(2) and 12606. It is an
- 13 affirmative defense to a prosecution or civil or administrative
- 14 action for a violation of this section that the owner, operator,
- 15 manager, or person in control of a food service establishment where
- 16 smoking is prohibited under this section made a good faith effort
- 17 to prohibit smoking by complying with section 12603(2). To assert
- 18 the affirmative defense under this subsection, the owner, operator,
- 19 manager, or person shall file a sworn affidavit setting forth his
- 20 or her efforts to prohibit smoking and his or her actions of
- 21 compliance with section 12603(2).
- 22 (6) An individual who violates this part shall be directed to
- 23 comply with this part and is subject to a civil fine of not more
- 24 than \$100.00 for a first violation and not more than \$500.00 for a
- 25 second or subsequent violation.
- 26 (7) As used in this section:
- 27 (a) "Food service establishment" means that term as defined in

- 1 section 1107 of the food law of 2000, 2000 PA 92, MCL 289.1107.
- 2 (b) "Shopping mall" means a shopping center with stores facing
- 3 an enclosed mall.
- 4 (c) "Smoking" OR "SMOKE" means that term as defined in section
- **5** 12601.
