

HOUSE BILL No. 5410

March 12, 2014, Introduced by Reps. Santana, Robinson, Singh and Kelly and referred to the Committee on Military and Veterans Affairs.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled
"Public health code,"
(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 13107a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 13107A. (1) A LICENSEE SHALL CONSPICUOUSLY DISPLAY A SIGN
2 IN AN AREA FREQUENTED BY CUSTOMERS TO WARN OF POSSIBLE
3 DISQUALIFICATIONS DUE TO CERTAIN TATTOOS. SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION
4 (2), THE SIGN MUST BE IN SUBSTANTIALLY THE FOLLOWING FORM:

5 "WARNING:
6 TATTOOS OF A CERTAIN SUBJECT MATTER AND IN A CERTAIN LOCATION MAY
7 DISQUALIFY AN INDIVIDUAL FROM ACCEPTANCE INTO MILITARY SERVICE,
8 EMPLOYMENT BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY, OR FURTHER PROMOTION BY A

1 LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY OR WITHIN A BRANCH OF THE ARMED SERVICES.".

2 (2) A LICENSEE SHALL ENSURE THAT THE SIGN REQUIRED UNDER
3 SUBSECTION (1) MEETS ALL OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

4 (A) IS AT LEAST 8.5 INCHES BY 11 INCHES IN SIZE.

5 (B) THE WORD "WARNING" IS PRINTED IN AT LEAST 96-POINT
6 BOLDFACED TYPE.

7 (C) THE BALANCE OF THE SIGN IS PRINTED IN AT LEAST 42-POINT
8 BOLDFACED TYPE.

9 (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:

10 (A) "ARMED FORCES" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 2 OF
11 THE VETERAN RIGHT TO EMPLOYMENT SERVICES ACT, 1994 PA 39, MCL
12 35.1092.

13 (B) "LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN
14 SECTION 2804.
