

# SENATE BILL No. 906

April 23, 2014, Introduced by Senators CASWELL, COLBECK, JONES, NOFS, PROOS, MARLEAU, EMMONS and BIEDA and referred to the Committee on Veterans, Military Affairs and Homeland Security.

A bill to amend 1967 PA 150, entitled  
"Michigan military act,"  
by amending section 411 (MCL 32.811), as amended by 2000 PA 472.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 411. (1) ~~A person~~ **AN INDIVIDUAL** who has completed not  
2       less than 20 years of active service with the national guard or  
3       defense force, or both, may retire and receive retirement pay under  
4       1 or more of the following circumstances:

5       (a) ~~Attainment of~~ **THE INDIVIDUAL IS** 62 years of age **OR OLDER**.

6       (b) Ineligibility, because of federal law or regulation, for  
7       further federal recognition in the ~~person's~~ **INDIVIDUAL'S** current  
8       grade because of age or length of service, and termination of the  
9       ~~person's~~ **INDIVIDUAL'S** commission or enlistment in the national  
10      guard of the United States.

11      (c) Withdrawal of the ~~person's~~ **INDIVIDUAL'S** federal

1 recognition and termination of the ~~person's~~**INDIVIDUAL'S** commission  
2 or enlistment in the national guard of the United States because of  
3 physical disqualification from further service.

4 (d) ~~Separation~~**THE INDIVIDUAL SEPARATES** from the national  
5 guard or defense force under an honorable circumstance.

6 (2) ~~A person~~**AN INDIVIDUAL** who retires under subsection (1)(a)  
7 shall receive pay of ~~\$600.00~~**\$720.00** per year. ~~A person~~**AN**  
8 **INDIVIDUAL** who retires under subsection (1)(b), (c), or (d) shall  
9 receive pay of ~~\$600.00~~**\$720.00** per year upon ~~reaching~~**ATTAINING** 55  
10 years of age.

11 (3) Upon the death of ~~a person~~**AN INDIVIDUAL** who has completed  
12 not less than 20 years of active service with the national guard or  
13 defense force, or both, and who before his or her death met 1 of  
14 the circumstances described in subsection (1)(b), (c), or (d), or  
15 was still in active service, ~~a~~**THE INDIVIDUAL'S** surviving spouse  
16 shall receive ~~\$500.00~~**\$600.00** per year until death.
