THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 5A. IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 23G OF CHAPTER X OF THE 2 PROBATE CODE OF 1939, 1939 PA 288, MCL 710.23G, AND SECTIONS 14E 3 AND 14F OF 1973 PA 116, MCL 722.124E AND 722.124F, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT TAKE AN ADVERSE ACTION AGAINST A CHILD PLACING AGENCY ON 4 5 THE BASIS THAT THE CHILD PLACING AGENCY HAS DECLINED OR WILL DECLINE TO PROVIDE SERVICES THAT CONFLICT WITH, OR PROVIDE SERVICES 6 7 UNDER CIRCUMSTANCES THAT CONFLICT WITH, THE CHILD PLACING AGENCY'S SINCERELY HELD RELIGIOUS BELIEFS CONTAINED IN A WRITTEN POLICY, 8 9 STATEMENT OF FAITH, OR OTHER DOCUMENT ADHERED TO BY THE CHILD 10 PLACING AGENCY.
