GENERAL SECTIONS
Sec. 201. In accordance with the provisions of section 30 of
article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending
from state resources in this appropriation act for the fiscal year

10 ending September 30, 2016 is \$25,183,500.00 and state

appropriations paid to local units of government are \$8,963,500.00.
Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized
under this act and the departments, commissions, boards, offices,
and programs for which appropriations are made under this act are
subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101
to 18.1594.

17 DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION

Sec. 301. From the funds appropriated in section 102 for the Flint declaration of emergency, the department of education shall allocate funds to address needs related to the declaration of emergency issued on January 5, 2016. These funds may support, but are not limited to, the following activities:

23 (a) Hiring additional school nurses.

24 (b) In the intermediate school district in which the

1 declaration of emergency has been made, providing early on and

2 special education services, coordinating wraparound services,

3 providing nutritional snacks to elementary students, and providing4 and coordinating communications for parents, educators, and the

5 community.

6 DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY

7 Sec. 401. From the funds appropriated in section 103 for the 8 Flint declaration of emergency, the department of environmental 9 quality shall allocate funds to address needs related to the 10 declaration of emergency issued on January 5, 2016. These funds may 11 support, but are not limited to, the following activities:

12 (a) Water system needs.

13 (b) Potential payment to city of Flint to aid with utility14 issues.

15 (c) Lab and testing costs.

16 (d) Corrosion control procedures.

17 (e) Infrastructure integrity study using outside experts.

18 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES

Sec. 501. From the funds appropriated in section 104 for the Flint declaration of emergency, the department of health and human services shall allocate funds to address needs related to the declaration of emergency issued on January 5, 2016. These funds may support, but are not limited to, the following activities:

24 (a) Purchases of bottled water, water filters, and replacement25 filter cartridges.

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- 1 (b) Department field operations costs.
- 2 (c) Epidemiological analysis and case management of
 3 individuals at risk of elevated blood lead levels.
- 4
 - (d) Nutrition support and community education.
- 5 (e) Support for child and adolescent health centers and6 children's health care access program.
- 7 (f) Assessment of potential linkages to other diseases.
- 8 (g) Food inspections.
- 9 (h) Crisis counseling and behavioral health services.

10 DEPARTMENT OF LICENSING AND REGULATORY AFFAIRS

11 Sec. 601. From the funds appropriated in section 105 for the 12 Flint declaration of emergency, the department of licensing and regulatory affairs shall allocate funds to address needs related to 13 the declaration of emergency issued on January 5, 2016. These funds 14 may support, but are not limited to, plumbing fixture replacements 15 16 in schools, child care and adult foster care centers, nursing homes, dialysis centers, and surgery centers within the city of 17 18 Flint.

19 DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AND VETERANS AFFAIRS

Sec. 701. From the funds appropriated in section 106 for the Flint declaration of emergency, the department of military and veterans affairs shall allocate funds to address needs related to the declaration of emergency issued on January 5, 2016. These funds may support, but are not limited to, the Michigan National Guard water support efforts.

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1 DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE

Sec. 801. From the funds appropriated in section 107 for the Flint declaration of emergency, the department of state police shall allocate funds to address needs related to the declaration of emergency issued on January 5, 2016. These funds may support, but are not limited to, operational funding for the Flint water interagency coordinating committee.
