HOUSE BILL No. 4832

August 19, 2015, Introduced by Reps. Chang, Plawecki, Kesto, Irwin and Howrylak and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled

"Public health code,"

by amending section 7405 (MCL 333.7405), as amended by 2012 PA 209.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 7405. (1) A person:
- 2 (a) Who is licensed by the administrator under this article
- 3 shall not distribute, prescribe, or dispense a controlled substance
- 4 in violation of section 7333.
- 5 (b) Who is a licensee AS DESCRIBED IN SUBDIVISION (A) shall
- 6 not manufacture a controlled substance not authorized by his or her
- 7 license or distribute, prescribe, or dispense a controlled
- 8 substance not authorized by his or her license to another licensee
- or other authorized person, except as authorized by rules
- 10 promulgated by the administrator.
 - (c) Shall not refuse an entry into any premises for an

- 1 inspection authorized by UNDER this article.
- 2 (d) Shall not knowingly keep or maintain a store, shop,
- 3 warehouse, dwelling, building, vehicle, boat, aircraft, or other
- 4 structure or place, that is frequented EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 5 (i) FREQUENTED by persons using controlled substances in
- 6 violation of this article for the purpose of using controlled
- 7 substances. , or that is used
- 8 (\ddot{u}) USED for keeping or selling controlled substances in
- 9 violation of this article. HOWEVER, THIS SUBPARAGRAPH DOES NOT
- 10 APPLY TO THE KEEPING OF CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ONLY FOR PERSONAL
- 11 USE.
- 12 (e) Who is a practitioner shall not dispense a controlled
- 13 substance under a prescription written and signed; written or
- 14 created in an electronic format, signed, and transmitted by
- 15 facsimile; or transmitted electronically or by other means of
- 16 communication by a physician prescriber or dentist prescriber
- 17 licensed to practice in a state other than Michigan, THIS STATE,
- 18 unless the prescription is issued by a physician prescriber or
- 19 dentist prescriber who is authorized under the laws of that THE
- 20 OTHER state to practice dentistry, medicine, or osteopathic
- 21 medicine and surgery and to prescribe controlled substances.
- 22 (2) A person who violates subsection (1) is subject to the
- 23 penalties prescribed in section 7406.
- 24 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 25 after the date it is enacted into law.
