THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 16220. (1) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF THIS ACT TO
- 2 THE CONTRARY, A PHYSICIAN OR QUALIFIED PERSON ASSISTING THE
- 3 PHYSICIAN IS IMMUNE FROM CRIMINAL PENALTY, CIVIL SANCTION, AND
- 4 ADMINISTRATIVE SANCTION FOR A FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH SECTION 17015,
- 5 17017, 17515, OR 17517 FOR PATIENT CARE PROVIDED TO A SPECIFIC
- 6 PATIENT IF, IN THE PHYSICIAN'S GOOD-FAITH MEDICAL JUDGMENT,
- 7 COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 17015, 17017, 17515, OR 17517 IN THAT CASE
- 8 IS INCONSISTENT WITH ACCEPTED, EVIDENCE-BASED MEDICAL PRACTICES OR
- 9 IS MEDICALLY INAPPROPRIATE FOR THE PATIENT. THIS SECTION DOES NOT
- 10 DO ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

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- 1 (A) ABROGATE THE PROFESSIONAL STANDARD OF CARE TO WHICH A
- 2 PHYSICIAN OR QUALIFIED PERSON ASSISTING THE PHYSICIAN IS EXPECTED
- 3 TO ADHERE.
- 4 (B) ALTER EXISTING STANDARDS FOR MEDICAL MALPRACTICE.
- 5 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 6 (A) "PATIENT CARE" MEANS ALL ASPECTS OF THE HEALTH CARE
- 7 PROFESSIONAL'S INTERACTION WITH A HUMAN PATIENT, INCLUDING THE
- 8 PROVISION OF INFORMATION AND CLINICAL CARE.
- 9 (B) "PHYSICIAN" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 17001 OR
- 10 17501.
- 11 (C) "QUALIFIED PERSON ASSISTING THE PHYSICIAN" MEANS THAT TERM
- 12 AS DEFINED IN SECTION 17015.
