HOUSE BILL No. 5101

December 1, 2015, Introduced by Reps. Plawecki, Chang, Garrett, Neeley, Geiss and Yanez and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to require all state departments and agencies to establish certain water affordability criteria; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local governmental officers and entities.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "human
 right to water act".

3 Sec. 2. (1) Each individual has the right to safe, clean,
4 affordable, and accessible water for human consumption, cooking,
5 and sanitary purposes.

6 (2) All state departments and agencies shall employ all
7 reasonable means to implement this section. All state departments
8 and agencies shall revise, adopt, or establish policies,
9 regulations, and grant criteria to further this section by

establishing water affordability criteria as appropriate, to the
 extent that those actions do not affect eligibility for federal
 funds.

4 (3) This section does not expand any obligation of this state
5 to provide water or to require the expenditure of additional
6 resources to develop water infrastructure beyond the obligations
7 that may exist under subsection (2).

8 (4) This section applies to water supplies for individuals and9 not for new development in this state.

10 (5) The implementation of this section does not infringe on 11 the rights or responsibilities of any public water system in this 12 state.
