1 PART 149. COAL TAR PRODUCTS

2 SEC. 14901. AS USED IN THIS PART:

3 (A) "COAL TAR SEALANT" MEANS A SURFACE-APPLIED PRODUCT

4 CONTAINING COAL TAR, COAL TAR PITCH, COAL TAR PITCH VOLATILES, RT-

5 12, REFINED TAR, OR ANY VARIATION OF THOSE SUBSTANCES ASSIGNED THE

6 CHEMICAL ABSTRACTS SERVICE (CAS) NUMBERS 65996-92-1, 65996-93-2,

65996-89-6, AND 8007-45-2 OR RELATED SUBSTANCES CONTAINING MORE

- 13 PERSON IS RESEARCHING THE EFFECT OF A COAL TAR SEALANT OR OTHER
- 14 HIGH PAH SEALANT ON THE ENVIRONMENT OR IS DEVELOPING AN ALTERNATIVE
- 15 TECHNOLOGY, AND THE USE OF THE COAL TAR SEALANT OR OTHER HIGH PAH

- 20 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 21 after the date it is enacted into law.
