1	Sec. 175. Any person duly AN INDIVIDUAL elected to the office
2	of state senator or representative who desires to resign shall file
3	a written notice containing the effective date of such THE
4	resignation with the presiding officer of his OR HER respective
5	house, who shall immediately transmit the same WRITTEN NOTICE to
6	the governor. THE RESIGNATION OF AN INDIVIDUAL FROM THE OFFICE OF
7	STATE SENATOR OR REPRESENTATIVE REMAINS IN EFFECT FOR THE DURATION
8	OF THE UNEXPIRED LEGISLATIVE TERM.

Sec. 177. Any state senator or representative may be removed from office as provided in section 16 of article 4—IV of the state constitution OF 1963. THE REMOVAL OF AN INDIVIDUAL FROM THE OFFICE
