## **HOUSE BILL No. 5886**

September 15, 2016, Introduced by Reps. Garcia, Kelly, McBroom, Johnson, Rendon, Tedder, Iden and Singh and referred to the Committee on Commerce and Trade.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending section 310b (MCL 750.310b), as amended by 2010 PA 219.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 310b. (1) This chapter does not apply to a redemption
- 2 game if all of the following conditions are met:
- 3 (a) The outcome of the game is determined through the
- 4 application of an element of skill by the player.
- **5** (b) The award of the prize is based upon the player's
- 6 achieving the object of the game or otherwise upon the player's
- 7 score.
- 8 (c) Only noncash prizes, toys, novelties, or coupons or other
- 9 representations of value redeemable AT THE LOCATION WHERE THE GAMES
- 10 ARE PLAYED for noncash prizes, toys, or novelties are awarded. A
- 11 gift card may be awarded under this subdivision if all of the

- 1 following apply:
- 2 (i) The gift card is usable only at a retailer or an
- 3 affiliated group of retailers. THE LOCATION WHERE THE GAMES WERE
- 4 PLAYED.
- 5 (ii) The gift card is issued in a specified amount BY THE
- 6 BUSINESS WHERE THE GAMES WERE PLAYED.
- 7 (iii) The gift card is redeemable only for goods and services
- 8 available from the retailer or retailers BUSINESS and not for
- 9 CANNOT BE CONVERTED TO cash, INCLUDING THE GIVING OF CHANGE FOR A
- 10 PURCHASE.
- 11 (iv) Information on the gift card may not be altered with the
- 12 use of a personal identification number.
- 13 (d) The wholesale value of a prize, toy, or novelty awarded
- 14 for the successful single play of a game is not more than \$3.75.
- 15 (e) The redemption value of coupons or other representations
- 16 of value awarded for the successful single play of a game does not
- 17 exceed 15 times the amount charged for a single play of the game or
- 18 a \$3.75-per-play average, whichever is less. However, players may
- 19 accumulate coupons or other representations of value for redemption
- 20 for noncash prizes, toys, or novelties of a greater value up to,
- 21 but not exceeding, \$500.00 wholesale value.
- 22 (F) THE GAME IS REGISTERED WITH THE MICHIGAN GAMING CONTROL
- 23 BOARD.
- 24 (2) As used in this section: , "redemption
- 25 (A) "GIFT CARD" MEANS A WRITTEN PROMISE OR ELECTRONIC PAYMENT
- 26 DEVICE THAT IS HONORED UPON PRESENTATION AND IS USABLE FOR THE
- 27 FUTURE PURCHASE OR DELIVERY OF GOODS AND SERVICES. GIFT CARD DOES

- 1 NOT INCLUDE A GENERAL USE, PREPAID CARD, OR OTHER ELECTRONIC
- 2 PAYMENT DEVICE THAT IS ISSUED OR SPONSORED BY A FINANCIAL

- 5 (B) "REDEMPTION game" means a single player or multiplayer

- 7 game, the object of which is throwing, rolling, bowling, shooting,
- 8 placing, propelling, or stopping a ball or other object into, upon,
- 9 or against a hole or other target. Redemption game does not include

- 11 (i)  $\frac{(a)}{(a)}$  A game such as roulette, beano, cards, dice, wheel of
- 12 fortune, video poker, a slot machine, or another game in which
- 13 winning depends primarily upon fortuitous or accidental
- 14 circumstances beyond the control of the player.
- 15 (ii) A game that includes a mechanical or physical device
- 16 that directly or indirectly impairs or thwarts the skill of the
- 17 player.
- 18 (C) "REGISTERED" MEANS THAT THE OWNER OF THE LOCATION WHERE
- 19 THE GAME IS LOCATED NOTIFIES THE MICHIGAN GAMING CONTROL BOARD OF
- 20 THE PRESENCE OF THE GAME AT A PARTICULAR LOCATION AND PROVIDES THE
- 21 SERIAL NUMBER OR OTHER INFORMATION REQUESTED BY THE MICHIGAN GAMING
- 22 CONTROL BOARD. A GAME IS NOT CONSIDERED REGISTERED IF IT IS IN A
- 23 LOCATION OTHER THAN THE LOCATION PROVIDED TO THE MICHIGAN GAMING
- 24 CONTROL BOARD.
