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## **SENATE BILL No. 255**

April 14, 2015, Introduced by Senators WARREN, GREGORY, ANANICH, KNEZEK, HERTEL, SMITH and BIEDA and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 453, entitled "Elliott-Larsen civil rights act," by amending the title and section 502 (MCL 37.2502), the title as

amended by 1992 PA 258 and section 502 as amended by 1992 PA 124.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 TITLE

An act to define civil rights; to prohibit discriminatory practices, policies, and customs in the exercise of those rights based upon religion, race, color, national origin, age, sex, height, weight, familial status, or marital status; OR STATUS AS A VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE; to preserve the confidentiality of records regarding arrest, detention, or other disposition in which a conviction does not result; to prescribe the powers and duties of the civil rights commission and the department of civil rights; to provide remedies and penalties; to provide for fees; and to repeal

- 2 Sec. 502. (1) A person engaging in a real estate transaction,
- 3 or a real estate broker or salesman, shall not on the basis of
- 4 religion, race, color, national origin, age, sex, familial status,
- 5 or marital status of a person or a person residing with that
- 6 person, OR STATUS AS A VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, SEXUAL ASSAULT,
- 7 OR STALKING DO ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 8 (a) Refuse to engage in a real estate transaction with a
- 9 person.
- 10 (b) Discriminate against a person in the terms, conditions, or
- 11 privileges of a real estate transaction or in the furnishing of
- 12 facilities or services in connection with a real estate
- 13 transaction.
- 14 (c) Refuse to receive from a person or transmit to a person a
- 15 bona fide offer to engage in a real estate transaction.
- (d) Refuse to negotiate for a real estate transaction with a
- 17 person.
- 18 (e) Represent to a person that real property is not available
- 19 for inspection, sale, rental, or lease when in fact it is so
- 20 available, or knowingly fail to bring a property listing to a
- 21 person's attention, or refuse to permit a person to inspect real
- 22 property, or otherwise make unavailable or deny real property to a
- 23 person.
- 24 (f) Make, print, circulate, post, mail, or otherwise cause to
- 25 be made or published a statement, advertisement, notice, or sign,
- 26 or use a form of application for a real estate transaction, or make
- 27 a record of inquiry in connection with a prospective real estate

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- 1 transaction, which indicates, directly or indirectly, an intent to
- 2 make a preference, limitation, specification, or discrimination
- 3 with respect to the real estate transaction.
- 4 (g) Offer, solicit, accept, use, or retain a listing of real
- 5 property with the understanding that a person may be discriminated
- 6 against in a real estate transaction or in the furnishing of
- 7 facilities or services in connection therewith.
- 8 (h) Discriminate against a person in the brokering or
- 9 appraising of real property.
- 10 (2) A person shall not deny a person access to, or membership
- 11 or participation in, a multiple listing service, real estate
- 12 brokers' organization or other service, organization, or facility
- 13 relating to the business of selling or renting real property or to
- 14 discriminate against him or her in the terms or conditions of that
- 15 access, membership, or participation because of religion, race,
- 16 color, national origin, age, sex, familial status, or marital
- 17 status.

- 19 (4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 20 (A) "DOMESTIC VIOLENCE" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION
- 21 1 OF 1978 PA 389, MCL 400.1501.
- 22 (B) "SEXUAL ASSAULT" MEANS CONDUCT DESCRIBED IN SECTIONS 520A
- 23 TO 520G OF THE MICHIGAN PENAL CODE, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.520A TO
- 24 750.520G.
- 25 (C) "STALKING" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 411H OF
- 26 THE MICHIGAN PENAL CODE, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.411H.
