- 1 SEC. 545A. (1) THE COMMISSION, ON SUBMISSION OF A COMPLETED
- 2 APPLICATION, SHALL GRANT A HOME FOR THE AGED LICENSE TO AN
- 3 APPLICANT COMPLYING WITH THIS SECTION. THE TOTAL NUMBER OF LICENSES
- 4 ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY NOT EXCEED 20. IF THE HOLDER OF A
- 5 LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION GOES OUT OF BUSINESS, THE LICENSE
 - MUST BE SURRENDERED TO THE COMMISSION. THE COMMISSION MAY ALLOW THE
- 7 TRANSFER OF THE LICENSE TO A NEW BUSINESS OWNER ON TRANSFER OF THE
 - OWNER'S INTEREST IN THE BUSINESS.
- 9 (2) THE HOLDER OF A HOME FOR THE AGED LICENSE MAY SELL AT
- 10 RETAIL AND SERVE ON THE LICENSED PREMISES BEER, WINE, MIXED SPIRIT
