

SENATE BILL No. 863

March 24, 2016, Introduced by Senator BIEDA and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 2000 PA 92, entitled
"Food law,"
by amending section 6141 (MCL 289.6141).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 6141. (1) A food service establishment in which solid
2 foods are sold and consumed on the premises shall ~~prominently~~ DO
3 BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING:

4 (A) **PROMINENTLY** display a poster in the kitchen area of the
5 food service establishment diagramming and explaining the
6 antichoking techniques safe for both adults and children approved
7 by the department for dislodging foreign obstacles caught in the
8 throat of a choking person.

9 (B) HAVE ON ITS PREMISES, WHEN FOOD IS BEING SERVED, AN

1 EMPLOYEE TRAINED IN THE ANTICHOKING TECHNIQUES DESCRIBED IN
2 SUBDIVISION (A) .

3 (2) This section does not impose a duty upon the owners or
4 employees of a food service establishment to apply antichoking
5 techniques.

6 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
7 after the date it is enacted into law.
