## **HOUSE BILL No. 4510**

A bill to amend 1976 PA 453, entitled "Elliott-Larsen civil rights act," by amending section 801 (MCL 37.2801).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 801. (1) A person alleging a violation of this act may bring a civil action for appropriate injunctive relief or damages, or both. IF A COURT DETERMINES THAT AN EMPLOYER VIOLATED SECTION 202(C), THE COURT SHALL AWARD TREBLE DAMAGES.

(2) An action commenced <del>pursuant to **UNDER**</del> subsection (1) may be brought in the circuit court for the county where the alleged violation occurred, or for the county where the person against whom the civil complaint is filed resides or has his **OR HER** principal place of business.
