A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled

"Public health code,"

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by amending section 20199 (MCL 333.20199), and by adding section 21788.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 20199. (1) Except as OTHERWISE provided in subsection (2)

or section 20142, THIS ARTICLE, a person who violates this article
or a rule promulgated or an order issued under this article is
quilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by fine of not more than
\$1,000.00 for each day the violation continues or, in case of FOR a
violation of sections 20551 to 20554, a fine of not more than
\$1,000.00 for each occurrence.

(2) A person who violates sections 20181 to 20184 is guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or a fine of not more than \$2,000.00, or both.

- 13 (6) AN OWNER OR OPERATOR OR EMPLOYEE OF A NURSING HOME WHO
- 14 VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY
- 15 IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN
- 16 \$2,000.00, OR BOTH.
- 17 (7) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO WILLFULLY AND WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF THE
- 18 RESIDENT OR THE RESIDENT'S REPRESENTATIVE HAMPERS, OBSTRUCTS,
- 19 TAMPERS WITH, OR DESTROYS THE RESIDENT'S OR REPRESENTATIVE'S
- 20 ELECTRONIC MONITORING DEVICE OR ITS FILM, TAPE, OR OTHER RECORDING
- 21 MEDIUM IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR
- 22 NOT MORE THAN 90 DAYS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$2,000.00, OR
- 23 BOTH.
- 24 (8) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "ELECTRONIC MONITORING DEVICE"
- 25 MEANS A VIDEO SURVEILLANCE CAMERA, AN AUDIO DEVICE, A VIDEO
- 26 TELEPHONE, AN INTERNET VIDEO SURVEILLANCE DEVICE, OR A SIMILAR
- 27 DEVICE DESIGNED TO CAPTURE THE AUDIO RECORDINGS OR VISUAL IMAGES OF

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- 1 ITS SURROUNDINGS.
- 2 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 3 after the date it is enacted into law.
