

HOUSE BILL No. 5824

April 17, 2018, Introduced by Reps. Hughes, Victory and Lilly and referred to the Committee on Law and Justice.

A bill to amend 1965 PA 203, entitled
"Michigan commission on law enforcement standards act,"
(MCL 28.601 to 28.615) by adding section 9e.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 **SEC. 9E. AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS ISSUED A LICENSE UNDER THIS ACT**
2 **MUST FORWARD TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LICENSING AND REGULATORY AFFAIRS**
3 **ANY ALLEGATION RECEIVED BY THAT INDIVIDUAL THAT A HEALTH**
4 **PROFESSIONAL LICENSED OR REGISTERED UNDER ARTICLE 15 OF THE PUBLIC**
5 **HEALTH CODE, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.16101 TO 333.18838, HAS COMMITTED**
6 **ANY OF THE FOLLOWING ACTS:**

7 **(A) A VIOLATION OF SECTION 90 OF THE MICHIGAN PENAL CODE, 1931**
8 **PA 328, MCL 750.90.**

9 **(B) A VIOLATION OF SECTION 145C OF THE MICHIGAN PENAL CODE,**
10 **1931 PA 328, MCL 750.145C.**

1 (C) A VIOLATION OF SECTIONS 520B, 520C, 520D, 520E, OR 520G OF
2 THE MICHIGAN PENAL CODE, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.520B, 750.520C,
3 750.520D, 750.520E, AND 750.520G.

4 (D) ANY OTHER CRIMINAL ACT INVOLVING SEXUAL CONTACT OR SEXUAL
5 PENETRATION BY THAT HEALTH PROFESSIONAL. AS USED IN THIS
6 SUBDIVISION, "SEXUAL CONTACT" AND "SEXUAL PENETRATION" MEAN THOSE
7 TERMS AS DEFINED IN SECTION 520A OF THE MICHIGAN PENAL CODE, 1931
8 PA 328, MCL 750.520A.

9 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
10 after the date it is enacted into law.
