

SENATE BILL No. 127

February 9, 2017, Introduced by Senators JONES, NOFS, CONYERS, SCHUITMAKER and MARLEAU and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 479d.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 479D. (1) A PERSON WHO COMMITS OR ATTEMPTS TO COMMIT A
2 FELONY IN WHICH THE VICTIM IS TARGETED BECAUSE HE OR SHE IS, OR IS
3 PERCEIVED TO BE, A POLICE OFFICER, FIREFIGHTER, OR EMERGENCY
4 MEDICAL SERVICES PERSONNEL IS GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE BY
5 IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 2 YEARS, TO BE SERVED CONSECUTIVELY
6 TO ANY TERM OF IMPRISONMENT IMPOSED FOR THE UNDERLYING FELONY OR
7 ATTEMPTED FELONY.

8 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:

9 (A) "EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PERSONNEL" MEANS THAT TERM AS
10 DEFINED IN SECTION 20904 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE, 1978 PA 368,
11 MCL 333.20904.

1 (B) "FIREFIGHTER" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 2 OF
2 THE FIREFIGHTERS TRAINING COUNCIL ACT, 1966 PA 291, MCL 29.362.

3 (C) "POLICE OFFICER" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 2
4 OF THE MICHIGAN COMMISSION ON LAW ENFORCEMENT STANDARDS ACT, 1965
5 PA 203, MCL 28.602.

6 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
7 after the date it is enacted into law.
