

SENATE BILL No. 334

April 27, 2017, Introduced by Senator ANANICH and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make, supplement, and adjust appropriations for various state departments and agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2017; and to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations.

7 PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

8 **GENERAL SECTIONS**

9 Sec. 201. In accordance with the provisions of section 30 of
 10 article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending
 11 from state resources in this appropriation act for the fiscal year
 12 ending September 30, 2017 is \$0.00 and total state spending from
 13 state resources paid to local units of government is \$0.00.

14 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized
 15 under this act and the departments, commissions, boards, offices,
 16 and programs for which appropriations are made under this act are
 17 subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101
 18 to 18.1594.

19 **ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY**

20 Sec. 301. The unexpended funds appropriated in part 1 for the
 21 water infrastructure improvements for the nation act program are
 22 considered work project appropriations, and any unencumbered or
 23 unallotted funds are carried forward into the succeeding fiscal
 24 year. The following is in compliance with section 451a(1) of the

1 management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1451a:

2 (a) The purpose of the projects to be carried forward is to
3 provide water infrastructure improvements.

4 (b) The projects will be accomplished by contract.

5 (c) The total estimated cost of all projects is
6 \$100,000,000.00.

7 (d) The tentative completion date is September 30, 2021.

8 Sec. 302. From the funds appropriated in part 1, the
9 department shall provide quarterly reports to the speaker of the
10 house, the house minority leader, the senate majority leader, the
11 senate minority leader, and the house and senate fiscal agencies on
12 the expenditures from the \$100,000,000.00 in federal funds for the
13 water infrastructure improvements for the nation act program. The
14 reports shall be submitted by June 15, September 15, December 15,
15 and March 15, for each fiscal year during which the funds are
16 expended. Each quarterly report shall include, but is not limited
17 to, all of the following:

18 (a) The total amount of funds spent each quarter.

19 (b) The specific purpose or purposes for which the funds were
20 spent.

21 (c) The number of structures that had lead service lines
22 replaced and the average cost per replacement.

23 (d) An estimate of the amount of time remaining for project
24 completion.

25 (e) An estimate of the unexpended amount of total water
26 infrastructure improvements for the nation act appropriations and
27 state matching dollars that are still available.
