

# SENATE BILL No. 952

April 18, 2018, Introduced by Senators ZORN, KNOLLENBERG and NOFS and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled  
"The Michigan penal code,"  
by amending section 317a (MCL 750.317a), as added by 2005 PA 167.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1       Sec. 317a. (1) A person who delivers a schedule 1 or 2  
2 controlled substance, other than marihuana, to another person in  
3 violation of section 7401 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368,  
4 MCL 333.7401, that is consumed by that person or any other person  
5 and that causes the death of that person or other person is guilty  
6 of a felony punishable by imprisonment for life or any term of  
7 years.

8       (2) A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION MAY BE PROSECUTED IN THE  
9 COUNTY IN WHICH ANY OF THE FOLLOWING OCCURRED:

10       (A) THE COUNTY IN WHICH DELIVERY OF THE CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE

1 WAS MADE.

2 (B) THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE WAS CONSUMED.

3 (C) THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE DEATH CAUSED BY THE DELIVERY OF  
4 THE CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE OCCURRED.

5 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days  
6 after the date it is enacted into law.

7 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect  
8 unless Senate Bill No.\_\_\_\_ or House Bill No.\_\_\_\_ (request no.  
9 05611'17 a) of the 99th Legislature is enacted into law.
