Introduction of Bills

Rep. Sabo introduced

House Bill No. 5918, entitled

A bill to prohibit certain employers from requiring employees and employees' spouses and dependents to participate in certain activities; and to provide sanctions and remedies.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Commerce and Tourism.

A bill to amend 2011 PA 152, entitled "Publicly funded health insurance contribution act," by amending the title and section 9 (MCL 15.569) and by adding section 3a.
