2 (d) "Organized fire department" means that term as defined in
3 section 1 of the fire prevention code, 1941 PA 207, MCL 29.1.

4 (e) "PFAS" means a perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl
5 substance.

6 Sec. 14703. (1) Within 48 hours after an organized fire
7 department uses firefighting foam containing intentionally added
8 PFAS, the fire chief shall submit to the department of environment,
9 Great Lakes, and energy a written report that includes all of the
10 following information:

11 (a) The purpose for which the foam was used.

12 (b) The physical address and the latitude and longitude of the
13 location at which the foam was used.

14 (c) The quantity of foam concentrate used.

15 (d) The quantity of water used to produce the foam or used in
16 conjunction with the foam.

17 (e) The name brand and manufacturer of the foam concentrate.

18 (f) If a member of the organized fire department knows that
19 the foam or firewater entered a storm sewer or combined sewer, the
20 distance and direction of the point of entry from the location at
21 which the foam was used.

22 (g) If a member of the organized fire department knows that
23 the foam or firewater entered a water body, including, but not
24 limited to, a drain under the drain code of 1956, 1956 PA 40, MCL
25 280.1 to 280.630, the name or number of the water body and the
26 distance and direction of the point of entry from the location at
27 which the foam was used.

28 (h) Practices employed for containment and disposal of the
29 foam and firewater.



1 (i) Practices employed for cleanup and disposal of materials
2 contaminated by the foam concentrate, foam, or firewater.

3 (2) The department may prescribe the format of the report
4 under subsection (1) and the means by which the report shall be
5 submitted.

6 Sec. 14705. The department shall establish a collection
7 program for firefighting foam concentrate containing intentionally
8 added PFAS and establish guidelines for the program. Under the
9 program, the department shall accept the foam concentrate free of
10 charge and properly dispose of the foam concentrate. The program is
11 contingent on legislative appropriations to cover program costs.

12 Sec. 14707. A person that violates section 14703 may be
13 ordered to pay a civil fine of not more than \$500.00. A violation
14 of section 14703 may be prosecuted by the prosecutor of the county
15 in which the violation occurred or by the attorney general.
