A bill to amend 1976 PA 453, entitled "Elliott-Larsen civil rights act,"

by amending section 205a (MCL 37.2205a), as amended by 1999 PA 202.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 205a. (1) An employer, employment agency, or labor
- 2 organization, other than a law enforcement agency of this state or
- 3 a political subdivision of this state, shall not, in connection
- ${\bf 4}$  with an application for employment or membership  $\overline{\mbox{\it --}}{}$  or in connection





- 1 with the terms, conditions, or privileges of employment or
- 2 membership, request, make, or maintain a record of information
- 3 regarding a misdemeanor or felony arrest —or detention, or the
- 4 disposition of a misdemeanor, where if a conviction did not result.
- 5 A person is not guilty of perjury or otherwise for otherwise giving
- 6 a false statement by failing to recite or acknowledge information
- 7 the person has a civil right to withhold by under this section.
- 8 This section does not apply to information relative to a felony
- 9 charge before conviction or dismissal.
- 10 (2) As used in this section, "law enforcement agency" includes
- 11 the state department of corrections.
- 12 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 13 after the date it is enacted into law.
