THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 81f. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a person who assaults, batters, or assaults and batters an individual who performs his or her duties as a sports official immediately before, during, or after a sporting event, or at any other time if the assault, battery, or assault and battery directly arises from the sports official's execution of his or her duty as a sports
