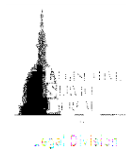

10 **GENERAL SECTIONS**

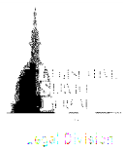
11 Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state
 12 constitution of 1963, total state spending from state sources under
 13 part 1 for fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 is \$6,000,000.00
 14 and total state spending from state sources to be paid to local
 15 units of government is \$6,000,000.00.

16 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized
 17 under this part and the departments, commissions, boards, offices,
 18 and programs for which appropriations are made under this part and
 19 part 1, are subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431,
 20 MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594.

21 Sec. 203. If the state administrative board, acting under
 22 section 3 of 1921 PA 2, MCL 17.3, transfers funds from an amount
 23 appropriated under this act, the legislature may, by a concurrent
 24 resolution adopted by a majority of the members elected to and
 25 serving in each house, inter-transfer funds within this act for the
 26 particular department, board, commission, office, or institution.

 28 **DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE**

29 Sec. 301. Funds appropriated in part 1 from the disaster and



1 emergency contingency fund shall be allocated to a county with a
2 population of more than 80,000 and less than 85,000 and to a city
3 with a population of more than 35,000 located in a county with a
4 population of more than 80,000 and less than 85,000, according to
5 the most recent federal decennial census. Funding shall be used to
6 reimburse project restoration costs and expenses caused by the
7 federally declared disaster in that county. Restoration projects
8 include, but are not limited to, debris removal, emergency
9 protective measures such as road blockades, sheltering, and
10 evacuations, chemical contamination clean-up efforts, and the
11 repair of real estate and personal property.
