A bill to amend 1995 PA 75, entitled "Empowerment zone development corporation act," by amending section 7 (MCL 125.2567).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 7. (1) A written application may be made by not less than persons to the governing body of a municipality with a population less than 900,000 for permission to incorporate an empowerment zone development corporation on behalf of the municipality. In a

- 2 empowerment zone coordinating council shall designate not less than
- 3 3 persons to apply. The application shall must include proposed
- 4 articles of incorporation and proposed bylaws. The name of the

- 6 corporation of " (the name of the incorporating
- 7 municipality).
- 8 (2) The governing body of the municipality shall notify the
