## **HOUSE BILL NO. 6377**

November 12, 2020, Introduced by Reps. Coleman, Meerman and Steven Johnson and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1966 PA 293, entitled

"An act to provide for the establishment of charter counties; to provide for the election of charter commissioners; to prescribe their powers and duties; to prohibit certain acts of a county board of commissioners after the approval of the election of a charter commission; to prescribe the mandatory and permissive provisions of a charter; to provide for the exercise by a charter county of certain powers whether or not authorized by its charter; and to prescribe penalties and provide remedies,"

by amending sections 7 and 17 (MCL 45.507 and 45.517).

- 1 Sec. 7. (1) Upon the passage of the resolution, the county
- 2 clerk, within 3 business days, shall transmit a certified copy

- 21 commission fixing the date for the submission and election, the
- 22 county clerk, within 3 business days, shall transmit a certified
- 23 copy of the resolution, together with a copy of the proposed
- 24 charter, to the clerk of each city, village, and township within
- 25 his or her county.
- 26 (2) The Before January 1, 2022, the county clerk shall cause
- 27 the proposed charter to be published in at least 1 newspaper having
- 28 general circulation within the county. The Before January 1, 2022,
- 29 the charter shall must be published not less than 2 weeks nor or

- 1 more than 4 weeks prior to before the election. Beginning January
- 2 1, 2022, the county clerk shall, not less than 2 weeks or more than
- 3 4 weeks before the election, post public notice of the proposed
- 4 charter as set forth in the local government public notice act.
- 5 (3) The county clerk shall also cause to be published a notice
- 6 of election in accordance with to be provided as set forth in
- 7 section 7.
