HOUSE BILL NO. 6412

November 12, 2020, Introduced by Reps. Bolden, Meerman, Coleman and Steven Johnson and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 252g (MCL 257.252g), as amended by 2018 PA 347.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 252g. (1) Subject to section 252a(18), a public sale for
- 2 a vehicle and its contents that has been determined to be abandoned
- 3 under section 252a or removed under section 252d shall must be
- 4 conducted in the following manner:

- (a) It shall must be under the control of the police agency.
 However, a police agency may designate the custodian of the vehicle
 or a third party to conduct the auction.
- 4 (b) It shall must be open to the public and consist of open
 5 auction bidding or bidding by sealed bids. If sealed bids are
 6 received, the person submitting the bid shall receive a receipt for
 7 the bid from the police agency or the agency's designee or, if the
 8 vehicle is being sold under section 252a(18), the custodian of the
 9 vehicle.
- 10 (c) Except as otherwise provided in sections section 252a(18)

 11 and (19) and 252b(7), (20), it shall must be held not less than 5

 12 days after public notice of the sale has been published.
- (d) Except as otherwise provided in this subdivision \mathbf{or} 13 14 subdivision (e), the public notice shall must be published at least 15 once in a newspaper having a general circulation within the county 16 in which the vehicle was abandoned. The public notice shall must give a description of the vehicle for sale and shall must state the 17 18 time, date, and location of the sale. The requirements of this subdivision may be satisfied by publishing a notice of the public 19 20 auction once in a newspaper having a general circulation within the 21 county in which the auction is to occur, if the notice states that 22 the auction is an abandoned vehicle auction, lists the date, time, 23 and location of the auction, and provides a website address where a 24 complete description of each vehicle to be auctioned appears for 25 not less than 5 consecutive days before the date of the auction. As used in this subdivision, "complete description" means a 26 27 description of the vehicle's model year, manufacturer make, model name, and vehicle identification number. 28
 - (e) Beginning January 1, 2022, a police agency or other

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- 1 governmental agency required to provide public notice under this
- 2 section shall post the public notice in the county in which the
- 3 vehicle was abandoned as provided in the local government public
- 4 notice act. The public notice must give a description of the
- 5 vehicle for sale and must state the time, date, and location of the
- 6 sale. The requirements of this subdivision may be satisfied by
- 7 posting a notice of the public auction in the county in which the
- 8 auction is to occur as provided in the local government public
- 9 notice act, if the notice states that the auction is an abandoned
- 10 vehicle auction, lists the date, time, and location of the auction,
- 11 and provides a website address where a complete description of each
- 12 vehicle to be auctioned appears for not less than 5 consecutive
- 13 days before the date of the auction.
- 14 (2) The money received from the public sale of the vehicle
 15 shall must be applied in the following order of priority:
- 16 (a) Accrued towing and storage charges. However, if the money
- 17 received from the public sale does not satisfy the accrued towing
- 18 and storage charges, the towing company may collect the balance of
- 19 those unpaid fees from the last titled owner, subject to section
- 20 252i.
- 21 (b) Expenses incurred by the police agency or the custodian of
- 22 the vehicle.
- (c) Payment of the \$40.00 abandoned vehicle fee described in
- **24** section 252f(3)(a).
- (d) Any extra money shall be sent to the department of
- 26 treasury's unclaimed property division to be disbursed as follows:
- 27 (i) To the secured party, if any, in the amount of the debt
- 28 outstanding on the vehicle.
- 29 (ii) Remainder to the owner. A reasonable attempt shall be made

- 1 to mail the remainder to the last titled owner. If delivery of the
- 2 remainder cannot be accomplished, the remainder shall become the
- 3 property of the unit of government governing the location from
- 4 which the vehicle was towed.
- 5 (3) If there are no bidders on the vehicle, the police agency
- 6 or the custodian of the vehicle may do 1 of the following:
- 7 (a) Turn the vehicle over to the towing firm or the custodian
- 8 of the vehicle to satisfy charges against the vehicle. However, if
- 9 the value of the vehicle does not satisfy the towing fees and
- 10 accrued daily storage fees, the custodian of the vehicle may
- 11 collect the balance of those unpaid fees from the last titled
- 12 owner, subject to section 252i.
- 13 (b) Obtain title to the vehicle for the police agency or the
- 14 unit of government the police agency represents, by doing the
- 15 following:
- 16 (i) Paying the towing and storage charges.
- 17 (ii) Applying for title to the vehicle.
- 18 (c) Hold another public sale under subsection (1).
- 19 (4) A person who acquires ownership of a vehicle under
- 20 subsection (1) or (3) that has been designated as a distressed
- 21 vehicle shall apply for a salvage certificate of title within 15
- 22 days after obtaining the vehicle.
- 23 (5) Upon disposition of the vehicle, the police agency or
- 24 towing agency or custodian shall provide the secretary of state and
- 25 the police agency, if that police agency did not conduct the sale,
- 26 with the vehicle's disposition and the name of the agency that
- 27 disposed of it and the police agency shall cancel the entry in the
- 28 law enforcement information network.
- 29 (6) Not less than 25 days after the date of notice required

- 1 under section 252a, if the police agency does not provide a copy of
- 2 the bill of sale by the police agency for the abandoned vehicle to
- 3 the towing agency or custodian or police agency's designee, the
- 4 towing agency or custodian or police agency designee may obtain an
- 5 original of the bill of sale by submitting an application to the
- 6 secretary of state in a form as determined by the secretary of
- 7 state.
- 8 (7) As used in this section, "complete description" means a
- 9 description of the vehicle's model year, manufacturer make, model
- 10 name, and vehicle identification number.
- 11 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 12 unless Senate Bill No. or House Bill No. 6440 (request no.
- 13 02449'19) of the 100th Legislature is enacted into law.
