THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 152a. (1) The Michigan judicial institute shall provide
- 2 training for judges serving as judges of the probate court and

- 3 (2) The training required under this section must be offered
- 4 not less than once every 2 years and must include information on
- 5 all of the following subjects:
- 6 (a) The nature, extent, and causes of domestic violence,
- 7 stalking, and criminal sexual conduct.
- 8 (b) Procedures designed to promote the safety of the victim
- 9 and other household members.
- 10 (c) Information about the neurobehavioral effects of trauma
- 11 and signs of abuse, especially as these relate to an individual's
- 12 presentation and manner in court.
- 13 (d) Information about the prevalence and human economic impact
- 14 of domestic violence on society.
- 15 (e) Statistical information on domestic violence as it relates
- 16 to child custody, including its lethality, outcomes of contested
- 17 custody cases in which a spouse alleges abuse, and child deaths or
- 18 removals from the home following contested custody cases.
- 19 (3) As used in this section:
- 20 (a) "Criminal sexual conduct" means conduct prohibited under
- 21 section 520b, 520c, 520d, 520e, or 520g of the Michigan penal code,
- 22 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.520b, 750.520c, 750.520d, 750.520e, and
- 23 750.520q.
- 24 (b) "Domestic violence" means that term as defined in section
- 25 1 of 1978 PA 389, MCL 400.1501.
- 26 (c) "Stalking" means conduct prohibited under section 411h or
- 27 411i of the Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.411h and
- 28 750.411i.
